Feeling or revealing an overt sexual interest or desire. lascivious

He gave her a lascivious wink.

Given to excessive indulgence in sexual activity. lecherous

A **lecherous** gleam in his eye.

Driven by lust; preoccupied with or exhibiting lustful desires. lewd

Lewd pictures.

Driven by lust; preoccupied with or exhibiting lustful desires. libidinous

Libidinous orgies.

Lacking moral discipline; especially sexually unrestrained. licentious

Coarse and **licentious** men.

Smooth and slippery with oil or a similar substance. **lubricious**

Eluding **lubricious** embraces.

Characterized by lust. prurient

Prurient thoughts.

Characterized by lust. salacious

Salacious limericks.
