- Driven by lust; preoccupied with or exhibiting lustful desires.
- Characterized by lust.





Synonyms of "Lustful" as an adjective (10 Words)

concupiscent	Filled with sexual desire; lustful. Concupiscent dreams.
lascivious	Feeling or revealing an overt sexual interest or desire. <i>He gave her a lascivious wink.</i>
<u>lecherous</u>	Given to excessive indulgence in sexual activity. A lecherous gleam in his eye.
lewd	Driven by lust; preoccupied with or exhibiting lustful desires. <i>Lewd pictures</i> .
libidinous	Driven by lust; preoccupied with or exhibiting lustful desires. <i>Libidinous orgies</i> .
licentious	Lacking moral discipline; especially sexually unrestrained. <i>Coarse and licentious men.</i>
lubricious	Smooth and slippery with oil or a similar substance. <i>Eluding lubricious embraces.</i>
prurient	Characterized by lust. Prurient thoughts.
salacious	Characterized by lust. <i>Salacious</i> limericks.
