## Associations of "Make a change" (30 Words)

<b>adjustment</b>	The act of adjusting something to match a standard. <i>Only slight <b>adjustments</b> to the boat are necessary.</i>
<b><u>alter</u></b>	Make an alteration to. <i>This dress needs to be <b>altered</b>.</i>
<b>compatibility</b>	A feeling of sympathetic understanding. <i>They felt the bond of true <b>compatibility</b>.</i>
<b><u>conversion</u></b>	Act of exchanging one type of money or security for another. <i><b>Conversion</b> from Fahrenheit to Centigrade.</i>
<b>convert</b>	A person who has been converted to another religious or political belief. <i><b>Convert</b> slaves to laborers.</i>
<b>defection</b>	The state of having rejected your religious beliefs or your political party or a cause (often in favor of opposing beliefs or causes). <i>A number of <b>defections</b> by leading ballet dancers.</i>
<b>disabuse</b>	Persuade (someone) that an idea or belief is mistaken. <i>He quickly <b>disabused</b> me of my fanciful notions.</i>
<b><u>diversion</u></b>	An activity that diverts the mind from tedious or serious concerns; a recreation or pastime. <i>The road was closed and <b>diversions</b> put into operation.</i>
<b>fluctuation</b>	An irregular rising and falling in number or amount; a variation. <i>The current <b>fluctuation</b> in energy prices.</i>
<b>interchange</b>	A station where passengers may change from one railway line, bus service, etc. to another. <i><b>Interchange</b> this screw for one of a smaller size.</i>
<b><u>interchangeable</u></b>	Such that the arguments or roles can be interchanged. <i><b>Interchangeable</b> electric outlets.</i>
<b>metamorphose</b>	Change completely the nature or appearance of. <i>The extreme heat <b>metamorphosed</b> the sandstone baking it white and producing a quartzite rock.</i>

<b><u>modification</u></b>	The act of making something different (as e.g. the size of a garment). <i>The neighborhood had undergone few <b>modifications</b> since his last visit years ago.</i>
<b>modify</b>	Add a modifier to a constituent. <i>Please <b>modify</b> this letter to make it more polite.</i>
<b>permute</b>	Change the order or arrangement of. <i>We wish to <b>permute</b> the order of the bytes.</i>
<b>remold</b>	Give new treads to (a tire).
<b>replace</b>	Put (something) back in a previous place or position. <i>He drained his glass and <b>replaced</b> it on the bar.</i>
<b>reschedule</b>	Arrange a new scheme of repayments of (a debt). <i>The concert has been <b>rescheduled</b> for September.</i>
<b>revisal</b>	The act of rewriting something.
<b>revise</b>	Revise or reorganize especially for the purpose of updating and improving. <i>He had cause to <b>revise</b> his opinion a moment after expressing it.</i>
<b>transfigure</b>	Change completely the nature or appearance of. <i>The world is made luminous and is <b>transfigured</b>.</i>
<b><u>transform</u></b>	Change a mathematical entity by transformation. <i><b>Transform</b> energy to light.</i>
<b>transformation</b>	A sudden dramatic change of scenery on stage. <i>British society underwent a radical <b>transformation</b>.</i>
<b>transition</b>	Make or undergo a transition from one state or system to another. <i>He began the <b>transition</b> from female to male in the 10th grade.</i>
<b>transmogrify</b>	Transform in a surprising or magical manner. <i>His home was transmogrified into a hippy crash pad.</i>
<b><u>transmute</u></b>	Alter the nature of (elements). <i>The quest to <b>transmute</b> lead into gold.</i>
<b>turnabout</b>	Turning in the opposite direction. <i>The move was a significant <b>turnabout</b> for the company.</i>
<b><u>variability</u></b>	The quality of being uneven and lacking uniformity. <i>A great deal of <b>variability</b> in quality.</i>
<b><u>variance</u></b>	A quantity equal to the square of the standard deviation. <i>They were at <b>variance</b> with all their previous allies.</i>
<b><u>vary</u></b>	Become different in some particular way, without permanently losing one's or its former characteristics or essence. <i>The properties <b>vary</b> in price.</i>
