## Associations of "Manipulating" (30 Words)

<b>abominable</b>	Unequivocally detestable- Edmund Burke. <i>What an <b>abominable</b> mess.</i>
<b>aileron</b>	An airfoil that controls lateral motion.
<b><u>alter</u></b>	Make an alteration to. <i>Our outward appearance <b>alters</b> as we get older.</i>
<b><u>brainwash</u></b>	Submit to brainwashing indoctrinate forcibly. <i>People are <b>brainwashed</b> into believing family life is the best.</i>
<b>contort</b>	Twist and press out of shape. <i>A spasm of pain <b>contorted</b> his face.</i>
<b>crimp</b>	A small connecting piece for crimping wires or lines together. <i>Mum <b>crimped</b> my hair for the party.</i>
<b>deform</b>	Become distorted or misshapen undergo deformation. <i>His body was <b>deformed</b> by leprosy.</i>
<b><u>deformed</u></b>	So badly formed or out of shape as to be ugly. <i>His <b>deformed</b> hands.</i>
<b>disfigure</b>	Mar or spoil the appearance of. <i>The vandals <b>disfigured</b> the statue.</i>
<b><u>distort</u></b>	Twist and press out of shape. <i>You re <b>distorting</b> the sound by overdriving the amp.</i>
<b>flex</b>	The act of flexing. <i>A group of bodybuilders <b>flexed</b> their muscles.</i>
<b>garble</b>	A garbled account or transmission. <i>Most readers assumed the word was a typographical <b>garble</b>.</i>
<b>handle</b>	The feel of goods especially textiles when handled. <i>This blender can t <b>handle</b> nuts.</i>

<b><u>insinuate</u></b>	Introduce or insert (oneself) in a subtle manner. <i>He <b>insinuated</b> himself into the conversation of the people at the nearby table.</i>
<b>irreversibly</b>	In a way that cannot be undone or altered. <i>Our landscape will be <b>irreversibly</b> damaged.</i>
<b>kink</b>	Form a curl curve or kink. <i>Though the system is making some headway there are still some <b>kinks</b> to iron out.</i>
<b>mutate</b>	Undergo mutation. <i>The virus is able to <b>mutate</b> into new forms that are immune to the vaccine.</i>
<b>operate</b>	(of a person) control the functioning of (a machine, process, or system). <i>Doctors refused to <b>operate</b> because of the risks involved.</i>
<b>overstate</b>	To enlarge beyond bounds or the truth. <i>I <b>overstated</b> my case to make my point.</i>
<b><u>pervert</u></b>	Practice sophistry; change the meaning of or be vague about in order to mislead or deceive. <i>Hector is a man who is simply <b>perverted</b> by his time.</i>
<b>retouch</b>	Give retouches to hair. <i>This photograph has been <b>retouched</b>.</i>
<b>torsion</b>	A twisting force.
<b>transformed</b>	Given a completely different form or appearance. <i>Shocked to see the <b>transformed</b> landscape.</i>
<b><u>twist</u></b>	A paper packet with twisted ends. <i>It broke off after much <b>twisting</b>.</i>
<b>warp</b>	In weaving arrange yarn so as to form the warp of a piece of cloth. <i>The main canal may be cut so as to <b>warp</b> the lands on each side of it.</i>
<b>wrench</b>	Turn something especially a nut or bolt with a wrench. <i><b>Wrench</b> one's ankle.</i>
<b>wrest</b>	Obtain by seizing forcibly or violently, also metaphorically. <i>Leila tried to <b>wrest</b> her arm from his hold.</i>
<b>wrestle</b>	Take part in a fight, either as sport or in earnest, that involves grappling with one's opponent and trying to throw or force them to the ground. <i>She <b>wrestled</b> the keys out of the ignition.</i>
<b>wry</b>	Humorously sarcastic or mocking. <i>A remedy for <b>wry</b> necks.</i>
