# **Conjugate Manse**

## Manse in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I manse	We <b>manse</b>
You <b>manse</b>	You <b>manse</b>
He/She/It manses	They manse

## Manse in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am mansing	We are mansing
You <b>are mansing</b>	You <b>are mansing</b>
He/She/It is mansing	They are mansing

#### **Manse in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have mansed	We have mansed
You have mansed	You have mansed
He/She/It has mansed	They have mansed

## **Manse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been mansing	We have been mansing
You <b>have been mansing</b>	You have been mansing
He/She/It has been mansing	They have been mansing

# Manse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I mansed	We <b>mansed</b>
You <b>mansed</b>	You <b>mansed</b>
He/She/It mansed	They $\boldsymbol{mansed}$

## Manse in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was mansing	We were mansing
You <b>were mansing</b>	You <b>were mansing</b>
He/She/It was mansing	They were mansing

#### **Manse in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had mansed	We had mansed
You had mansed	You had mansed
He/She/It had mansed	They had mansed

### **Manse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been mansing	We had been mansing
You <b>had been mansing</b>	You <b>had been mansing</b>
He/She/It had been mansing	They had been mansing

# Manse in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will manse</b>	We <b>will manse</b>
You <b>will manse</b>	You <b>will manse</b>
He/She/It will manse	They will manse

# Manse in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be mansing	We will be mansing
You <b>will be mansing</b>	You <b>will be mansing</b>
He/She/It will be mansing	They will be mansing

### **Manse in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Manse in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been mansing	We <b>will have been mansing</b>
You <b>will have been mansing</b>	You <b>will have been mansing</b>
He/She/It will have been mansing	They will have been mansing
