Mark in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I mark	We mark
You mark	You mark
He/She/It marks	They mark

Mark in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am marking	We are marking
You are marking	You are marking
He/She/It is marking	They are marking

Mark in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have marked	We have marked
You have marked	You have marked
He/She/It has marked	They have marked

Mark in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been marking	We have been marking
You have been marking	You have been marking
He/She/It has been marking	They have been marking

Mark in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I marked	We marked
You marked	You marked
He/She/It marked	They marked

Mark in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was marking	We were marking
You were marking	You were marking
He/She/It was marking	They were marking

Mark in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had marked	We had marked
You had marked	You had marked
He/She/It had marked	They had marked

Mark in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been marking	We had been marking
You had been marking	You had been marking
He/She/It had been marking	They had been marking

Mark in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will mark	We will mark
You will mark	You will mark
He/She/It will mark They will mark	

Mark in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be marking	We will be marking
You will be marking	You will be marking
He/She/It will be marking	They will be marking
