Masculine as an Adjective

Definitions of "Masculine" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “masculine” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *(music or poetry) ending on an accented beat or syllable.*
- *Having qualities or appearance traditionally associated with men.*
- *Associated with men and not with women.*
- *Of or denoting a gender of nouns and adjectives, conventionally regarded as male.*
- *Ending on an accented beat or syllable.*
- *Of grammatical gender.*
- *Relating to men; male.*



Synonyms of "Masculine" as an adjective (6 Words)

macho	Masculine in an overly assertive or aggressive way. <i>The big macho tough guy.</i>
male	Relating to men or the male gender. <i>Male children.</i>
manlike	Resembling human beings. <i>A manlike creature.</i>
<u>manly</u>	Possessing qualities befitting a man. <i>Manly sports.</i>
red-blooded	Endowed with or exhibiting great bodily or mental health.
<u>virile</u>	Characterized by energy and vigor. <i>He was a powerful virile man.</i>



Usage Examples of "Masculine" as an adjective

- A *masculine* cadence.

- *Masculine pronouns.*
- *The masculine rhyme of `annoy, enjoy.*
- *A masculine voice.*
- *He is outstandingly handsome and robust, very masculine.*



Associations of "Masculine" (30 Words)

bold	A bold typeface or letter. <i>A figure carved in bold relief.</i>
boyish	Of, like, or characteristic of a male child or young man. <i>A boyish grin.</i>
<u>brave</u>	People who are brave. <i>It was a time to remember the brave.</i>
courage	Strength in the face of pain or grief. <i>She called on all her courage to face the ordeal.</i>

father	A male parent also used as a term of address to your father. <i>His father was born in Atlanta.</i>
gamete	A mature haploid male or female germ cell which is able to unite with another of the opposite sex in sexual reproduction to form a zygote.
genital	Relating to the human or animal reproductive organs. <i>The genital area.</i>
gentleman	A man of good social position, especially one of wealth and leisure. <i>He behaved throughout like a perfect gentleman.</i>
<u>guy</u>	Steady or support with a guy wire or cable. <i>He s a nice guy.</i>
homosexual	Someone who practices homosexuality having a sexual attraction to persons of the same sex. <i>Homosexual desire.</i>
impotence	An inability (usually of the male animal) to copulate. <i>People speak constantly of their social and political impotence.</i>
laddie	A male child (a familiar term of address to a boy). <i>He s just a wee laddie.</i>
libido	Sexual desire. <i>A deficient libido.</i>
macho	A man who is masculine in an overly assertive or aggressive way. <i>I realized just what a macho I was at heart.</i>
male	An animal that produces gametes spermatozoa that can fertilize female gametes ova. <i>A male infant.</i>
man	All of the living human inhabitants of the earth. <i>He awaited word from his man in Havana.</i>
manlike	Resembling human beings. <i>A manlike creature.</i>
manliness	The fact of being typically male; masculinity. <i>The author s alleged lack of manliness.</i>
<u>manly</u>	In a manful manner; with qualities thought to befit a man. <i>A manly torso of perfect proportions.</i>
<u>muscular</u>	Having a robust muscular body build characterized by predominance of structures bone and muscle and connective tissue developed from the embryonic mesodermal layer. <i>His legs were strong and muscular.</i>

robust	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. <i>The experiment yielded robust results.</i>
<u>sir</u>	Used as a polite or respectful way of addressing a man, especially one in a position of authority. <i>Excuse me sir.</i>
testosterone	A potent androgenic hormone produced chiefly by the testes; responsible for the development of male secondary sex characteristics.
tom	A black man considered to be excessively obedient or servile to white people. <i>Roscoe is tomming around now.</i>
<u>tough</u>	Feeling physical discomfort or pain tough is occasionally used colloquially for bad. <i>A tough all weather fabric.</i>
<u>valiant</u>	Possessing or showing courage or determination. <i>A valiant attempt to prevent the hijack.</i>
<u>virile</u>	Capable of copulation. <i>A strong virile performance of the Mass.</i>
<u>virility</u>	(in a man) the quality of having strength, energy, and a strong sex drive; manliness. <i>Great importance is placed on a man's virility.</i>
