## Masculine as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Masculine" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “masculine” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *(music or poetry) ending on an accented beat or syllable.*
- *Having qualities or appearance traditionally associated with men.*
- *Associated with men and not with women.*
- *Of or denoting a gender of nouns and adjectives, conventionally regarded as male.*
- *Ending on an accented beat or syllable.*
- *Of grammatical gender.*
- *Relating to men; male.*



## Synonyms of "Masculine" as an adjective (6 Words)

<b>macho</b>	Masculine in an overly assertive or aggressive way. <i>The big <b>macho</b> tough guy.</i>
<b>male</b>	Relating to men or the male gender. <i><b>Male</b> children.</i>
<b>manlike</b>	Resembling human beings. <i>A <b>manlike</b> creature.</i>
<b>manly</b>	Possessing qualities befitting a man. <i><b>Manly</b> sports.</i>
<b>red-blooded</b>	Endowed with or exhibiting great bodily or mental health.
<b>virile</b>	Characterized by energy and vigor. <i>He was a powerful <b>virile</b> man.</i>

- boyish** Of, like, or characteristic of a male child or young man.  
*A **boyish** grin.*
- brave** People who are brave.  
*It was a time to remember the **brave**.*
- courage** Strength in the face of pain or grief.  
*She called on all her **courage** to face the ordeal.*

<b>father</b>	A male parent also used as a term of address to your father. <i>His <b>father</b> was born in Atlanta.</i>
<b>gamete</b>	A mature haploid male or female germ cell which is able to unite with another of the opposite sex in sexual reproduction to form a zygote.
<b>genital</b>	Relating to the human or animal reproductive organs. <i>The <b>genital</b> area.</i>
<b>gentleman</b>	A man of good social position, especially one of wealth and leisure. <i>He behaved throughout like a perfect <b>gentleman</b>.</i>
<b><u>guy</u></b>	Steady or support with a guy wire or cable. <i>He s a nice <b>guy</b>.</i>
<b>homosexual</b>	Someone who practices homosexuality having a sexual attraction to persons of the same sex. <i><b>Homosexual</b> desire.</i>
<b>impotence</b>	An inability (usually of the male animal) to copulate. <i>People speak constantly of their social and political <b>impotence</b>.</i>
<b>laddie</b>	A male child (a familiar term of address to a boy). <i>He s just a wee <b>laddie</b>.</i>
<b>libido</b>	Sexual desire. <i>A deficient <b>libido</b>.</i>
<b>macho</b>	A man who is masculine in an overly assertive or aggressive way. <i>I realized just what a <b>macho</b> I was at heart.</i>
<b>male</b>	An animal that produces gametes spermatozoa that can fertilize female gametes ova. <i>A <b>male</b> infant.</i>
<b>man</b>	All of the living human inhabitants of the earth. <i>He awaited word from his <b>man</b> in Havana.</i>
<b>manlike</b>	Resembling human beings. <i>A <b>manlike</b> creature.</i>
<b>manliness</b>	The fact of being typically male; masculinity. <i>The author s alleged lack of <b>manliness</b>.</i>
<b><u>manly</u></b>	In a manful manner; with qualities thought to befit a man. <i>A <b>manly</b> torso of perfect proportions.</i>
<b><u>muscular</u></b>	Having a robust muscular body build characterized by predominance of structures bone and muscle and connective tissue developed from the embryonic mesodermal layer. <i>His legs were strong and <b>muscular</b>.</i>

- robust** Marked by richness and fullness of flavor.  
*The experiment yielded **robust** results.*
- sir** Used as a polite or respectful way of addressing a man, especially one in a position of authority.  
*Excuse me **sir**.*
- testosterone** A potent androgenic hormone produced chiefly by the testes; responsible for the development of male secondary sex characteristics.
- tom** A black man considered to be excessively obedient or servile to white people.  
*Roscoe is **tomming** around now.*
- tough** Feeling physical discomfort or pain tough is occasionally used colloquially for bad.  
*A **tough** all weather fabric.*
- valiant** Possessing or showing courage or determination.  
*A **valiant** attempt to prevent the hijack.*
- virile** Capable of copulation.  
*A strong **virile** performance of the Mass.*
- virility** (in a man) the quality of having strength, energy, and a strong sex drive; manliness.  
*Great importance is placed on a man s **virility**.*
