adroit	Clever or skilful. His adroit replies to hecklers won him many followers.
<u>artisan</u>	(of food or drink) made in a traditional or non-mechanized way using high- quality ingredients. <i>The growing appreciation of artisan foods.</i>
<u>blacksmith</u>	A smith who forges and shapes iron with a hammer and anvil.
calligrapher	Someone skilled in penmanship.
<u>carpenter</u>	Do the work of a carpenter. She carpenter s and goes on archaeological digs.
chieftain	The head of a tribe or clan. Powerful feudal chieftain s.
<u>craftsman</u>	A skilled worker who practices some trade or handicraft. <i>As an actor he was a consummate craftsman.</i>



<u>deft</u>	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands. <i>The script was both</i> deft and literate.
dexterous	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands. Dexterous of hand and inventive of mind.
dextrous	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands.
expert	A person who is very knowledgeable about or skilful in a particular area. An expert in healthcare.
glazier	Someone who cuts flat glass to size.
handcraft	Make skilfully by hand. We handcraft all our paper.
<u>host</u>	Be the host of or for. They were always gracious host s at the numerous dinner parties they held for friends.
leader	The person who leads or commands a group, organization, or country. <i>A leader in the use of video conferencing.</i>
liege	City in eastern Belgium; largest French-speaking city in Belgium. <i>The king s lieges.</i>
lord	Make a lord of someone. <i>Lords and ladies were entertained here.</i>
mason	A Freemason. One course of massive stones roughly mason ed.
<u>overlord</u>	A ruler, especially a feudal lord. The Jews rebelled against their Roman overlord s.
<u>owner</u>	Someone who owns (is legal possessor of) a business. <i>He is the owner of a chain of restaurants.</i>
plumber	A craftsman who installs and repairs pipes and fixtures and appliances.
<u>proprietor</u>	The owner of a business, or a holder of property. <i>Chinese restaurant proprietors.</i>
silversmith	Someone who makes or repairs articles of silver.
skilled	Based on or proceeding from the ability to do something well. <i>Skilled draughtsmen</i> .
skillful	Done with delicacy and skill. The effect was achieved by skillful retouching.
skipper	Work as the skipper on a vessel. The skipper and one other man were convicted of smuggling.



<u>squad</u>	A small squad of policemen trained to deal with a particular kind of crime. The 39 year old actress and her squad snapped some pics together after the show.
tanner	A small coin of the United Kingdom worth six pennies; not minted since 1970. Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless tanner s.
workmanlike	Worthy of a good workman. The book is a workmanlike job with chronology and bibliography and index.
wright	United States aviation pioneer who (with his brother Orville Wright)
