### Definitions of "Meal" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “meal” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *The food served and eaten at one time.*
- *The food eaten during a meal.*
- *Any of the regular occasions in a day when a reasonably large amount of food is eaten.*
- *Coarsely ground foodstuff; especially seeds of various cereal grasses or pulse.*
- *Any of the occasions for eating food that occur by custom or habit at more or less fixed times.*



## Synonyms of "Meal" as a noun (2 Words)

**repast** The food served and eaten at one time.  
*A sumptuous **repast**.*

**snack** A sexually attractive person.  
*It ll be a **snack**.*

<b>appetizer</b>	<p>A small dish of food or a drink taken before a meal or the main course of a meal to stimulate one's appetite.</p> <p><i>The afternoon games served as an <b>appetizer</b> for the evening's heavyweight clash between Borussia Dortmund and Bayern Munich.</i></p>
<b>appetizing</b>	<p>Stimulating one's appetite.</p> <p><i>The <b>appetizing</b> aroma of sizzling bacon.</i></p>
<b>breakfast</b>	<p>Eat breakfast.</p> <p><i>I don't eat <b>breakfast</b>.</i></p>
<b>brunch</b>	<p>Combination breakfast and lunch; usually served in late morning.</p> <p><i>Breakfast was served so late as almost to constitute <b>brunch</b>.</i></p>
<b>delectable</b>	<p>Capable of arousing desire.</p> <p><i>The <b>delectable</b> Ms Davis.</i></p>
<b>delicious</b>	<p>Highly pleasant to the taste.</p> <p><i><b>Delicious</b> home baked brown bread.</i></p>

<b><u>dessert</u></b>	A dish served as the last course of a meal. A <b>dessert</b> of chocolate mousse.
<b>eat</b>	Eat a meal take a meal. <i>I didn't <b>eat</b> yet so I gladly accept your invitation.</i>
<b><u>flavor</u></b>	Lend flavor to.
<b>flavour</b>	A substance used to alter or enhance the taste of food or drink a flavouring. <i>Whitewashed walls and red roof tiles gave the resort a Mediterranean <b>flavour</b>.</i>
<b>food</b>	Anything that provides mental stimulus for thinking. <i>They had eaten their <b>food</b> and slept.</i>
<b>lunch</b>	Eat lunch. A <b>lunch</b> meeting.
<b>luncheon</b>	A formal lunch, or a formal word for lunch. <i>A ladies <b>luncheon</b> was taking place.</i>
<b><u>luscious</u></b>	Very sexually attractive. <i>The <b>luscious</b> brush strokes and warm colours of these late masterpieces.</i>
<b><u>palatable</u></b>	(of food or drink) pleasant to taste. <i>A device that made increased taxation more <b>palatable</b>.</i>
<b><u>partake</u></b>	Consume. <i>Visitors can <b>partake</b> in golfing or clay pigeon shooting.</i>
<b>pasta</b>	A dish that contains pasta as its main ingredient.
<b>postprandial</b>	Following a meal (especially dinner). <i>We were jolted from our <b>postprandial</b> torpor.</i>
<b>refreshment</b>	A light snack or drink. <i>An ample supply of liquid <b>refreshment</b>.</i>
<b>repast</b>	A meal. A sumptuous <b>repast</b> .
<b><u>sauce</u></b>	Provide a sauce for something season with a sauce. <i>None of your <b>sauce</b> said Aunt Edie.</i>
<b><u>savor</u></b>	Give taste to. <b>Savor</b> the soup.
<b><u>savory</u></b>	Any of several aromatic herbs or subshrubs of the genus <i>Satureja</i> having spikes of flowers attractive to bees. <i>A past that was scarcely <b>savory</b>.</i>
<b><u>snack</u></b>	Eat a snack. <i>It'll be a <b>snack</b>.</i>

**starter** Denoting something regarded as suitable for a person who is new to a particular activity, product, etc.

*The **starter** motor.*

**supper** A light evening meal; served in early evening if dinner is at midday or served late in the evening at bedtime.

*We had a delicious cold **supper**.*

**tang** A tart spicy quality.

*His words came out with a distinct **tang** of broad Lancashire.*

**vegetarian** Relating to vegetarians or vegetarianism.

*A **vegetarian** restaurant.*

**zesty** Marked by spirited enjoyment.
