flavour	A substance used to alter or enhance the taste of food or drink a flavouring. <i>The yoghurt comes in eight fruit flavours.</i>
food	Any nutritious substance that people or animals eat or drink or that plants absorb in order to maintain life and growth. <i>They had eaten their food and slept.</i>
luncheon	A formal lunch, or a formal word for lunch. <i>A ladies luncheon was taking place.</i>
<u>luscious</u>	(of food or drink) having a pleasingly rich, sweet taste. <i>A luscious and fragrant dessert wine.</i>
nip	Sever or remove by pinching or snipping. <i>His teeth nipped at her ear.</i>
<u>palatable</u>	(of an action or proposal) acceptable or satisfactory. <i>A very palatable local red wine.</i>

pasta	A dish that contains pasta as its main ingredient.
postprandial	Following a meal (especially dinner). <i>We were jolted from our postprandial torpor.</i>
refreshment	Activity that refreshes and recreates; activity that renews your health and spirits by enjoyment and relaxation. <i>Light refreshments are available.</i>
repast	The food served and eaten at one time. <i>A sumptuous repast.</i>
sauce	Provide a sauce for something season with a sauce. <i>None of your sauce said Aunt Edie.</i>
savor	Derive or receive pleasure from; get enjoyment from; take pleasure in. <i>Savor the soup.</i>
savory	Having an agreeably pungent taste. <i>A past that was scarcely savory.</i>
savour	The taste experience when a savoury condiment is taken into the mouth. <i>Their genuflections savoured of superstition and popery.</i>
snack	Eat a snack eat lightly. <i>It ll be a snack.</i>
sour	Make or become sour. <i>Many friendships have soured over borrowed money.</i>
supper	A meal consisting of the specified food with chips. <i>I was sent to bed without any supper.</i>
tang	Brown algae seaweed with serrated edges. <i>A full tang is used for strength.</i>
tangy	Tasting sour like a lemon. <i>A tangy salad.</i>
tasty	Very attractive or appealing. <i>A tasty snack.</i>
zesty	Having an agreeably pungent taste.
