# Mean in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

## Mean in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am meaning We are meaning
You are meaning You are meaning
He/She/It is meaning They are meaning

### **Mean in Present Perfect Tense**

SingularPluralI have meantWe have meantYou have meantYou have meantHe/She/It has meantThey have meant

## **Mean in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I have been meaning We have been meaning

You have been meaning

He/She/It has been meaning They have been meaning

# Mean in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI meantWe meantYou meantYou meantHe/She/It meantThey meant

# Mean in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was meaning We were meaning
You were meaning
He/She/It was meaning They were meaning

### Mean in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I had meant We had meant
You had meant You had meant
He/She/It had meant They had meant

### **Mean in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I had been meaning
You had been meaning
You had been meaning
He/She/It had been meaning
They had been meaning

## Mean in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI will meanWe will meanYou will meanYou will meanHe/She/It will meanThey will mean

## Mean in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be meaning
You will be meaning
He/She/It will be meaning
They will be meaning

#### Mean in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have meant
You will have meant
He/She/It will have meant
They will have meant

## **Mean in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I will have been meaning
You will have been meaning
He/She/It will have been meaning
They will have been meaning
