Infinitive	to meander
Present Tense	meander / meanders
Past Tense	meandered
Present Participle	meandering
Past Participle	meandered

# **Conjugate Meander**

#### Meander in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>meander</b>	We <b>meander</b>
You <b>meander</b>	You <b>meander</b>
He/She/It meanders	They <b>meander</b>

### **Meander in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am meandering	We are meandering
You <b>are meandering</b>	You <b>are meandering</b>
He/She/It is meandering	They are meandering

#### **Meander in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have meandered	We have meandered
You have meandered	You have meandered
He/She/It has meandered	They have meandered

### **Meander in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been meandering	We have been meandering
You <b>have been meandering</b>	You have been meandering
He/She/It has been meandering	They have been meandering

## Meander in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I meandered	We <b>meandered</b>
You <b>meandered</b>	You <b>meandered</b>
He/She/It <b>meandered</b>	They <b>meandered</b>

#### Meander in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was meandering	We were meandering
You were meandering	You were meandering
He/She/It was meandering	They were meandering

#### **Meander in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had meandered	We had meandered
You had meandered	You had meandered
He/She/It had meandered	They had meandered

#### **Meander in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been meandering	We had been meandering
You <b>had been meandering</b>	You <b>had been meandering</b>
He/She/It had been meandering	They had been meandering

## Meander in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will meander</b>	We <b>will meander</b>
You <b>will meander</b>	You <b>will meander</b>
He/She/It will meander	They <b>will meander</b>

## Meander in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be meandering	We will be meandering
You <b>will be meandering</b>	You will be meandering
He/She/It will be meandering	They will be meandering

#### **Meander in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have meanderedWe will have meanderedYou will have meanderedYou will have meanderedHe/She/It will have meanderedThey will have meandered

### **Meander in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been meandering	We <b>will have been meandering</b>
You <b>will have been meandering</b>	You <b>will have been meandering</b>
He/She/It will have been meandering	They will have been meandering
