## Associations of "Meant" (30 Words)

<a href="#">aim</a>	Specifically design a product, event, or activity for a certain public. <i>It was created with the conscious <b>aim</b> of answering immediate needs.</i>
<a href="#">animus</a>	A feeling of ill will arousing active hostility. <i>The author s <b>animus</b> towards her.</i>
<a href="#">artifice</a>	A deceptive maneuver (especially to avoid capture). <i>An industry dominated by <b>artifice</b>.</i>
<b>boor</b>	A crude uncouth ill-bred person lacking culture or refinement. <i>At last the big obnoxious <b>boor</b> had been dealt a stunning blow for his uncouth and belligerent manner.</i>
<b>browbeat</b>	Discourage or frighten with threats or a domineering manner; intimidate. <i>A witness is being <b>browbeaten</b> under cross examination.</i>
<b>churl</b>	A selfish person who is unwilling to give or spend. <i>This trio are used whenever some <b>churl</b> wants to have a pop at progressive rock.</i>
<b>consciously</b>	In a way that is directly perceptible to and under the control of the person concerned. <i>A vicious and <b>consciously</b> dishonest hatchet job.</i>
<b>deliberately</b>	Consciously and intentionally; on purpose. <i>She was working <b>deliberately</b>.</i>
<b>designed</b>	Done or made or performed with purpose and intent- Havelock Ellis. <i>The aircraft performed their <b>designed</b> functions well.</i>
<a href="#">headed</a>	Having an intellect or personality of a specified kind. <i>Woolly <b>headed</b> thinking.</i>
<b>hector</b>	(Greek mythology) a mythical Trojan who was killed by Achilles during the Trojan War. <i>She doesn t <b>hector</b> us about giving up things.</i>
<a href="#">intend</a>	Mean or intend to express or convey. <i>Pigs <b>intended</b> for human consumption.</i>

<b>intended</b>	Future; betrothed. <i>An <b>intended</b> insult.</i>
<b><u>intention</u></b>	A thing intended; an aim or plan. <i>He announced his <b>intention</b> to stand for re election.</i>
<b><u>intentional</u></b>	Done on purpose; deliberate. <i><b>Intentional</b> wrongdoing and harm.</i>
<b>intentionality</b>	The quality of mental states (e.g. thoughts, beliefs, desires, hopes) which consists in their being directed towards some object or state of affairs.
<b>intentionally</b>	With intention; in an intentional manner. <i>I wasn't sure if it was <b>intentionally</b> funny or not.</i>
<b>knowingly</b>	In a way that suggests one has secret knowledge or awareness. <i>When a journalist <b>knowingly</b> misleads their readers.</i>
<b>minded</b>	(usually followed by `to') naturally disposed toward. <i>Career <b>minded</b>.</i>
<b>niggard</b>	Ungenerous niggardly.
<b>purpose</b>	The quality of being determined to do or achieve something firmness of purpose. <i>State pensions are considered as earned income for tax <b>purposes</b>.</i>
<b>purposefully</b>	With a useful purpose. <i>We <b>purposefully</b> avoided addressing the problem.</i>
<b>purposely</b>	With intention; in an intentional manner. <i>She had <b>purposely</b> made it difficult.</i>
<b>reconfirm</b>	Confirm again. <i>Berghofer resigned but was <b>reconfirmed</b> as mayor of Dresden shortly afterwards.</i>
<b><u>signify</u></b>	Be of importance. <i><b>Signify</b> your agreement by signing the letter below.</i>
<b>skillfully</b>	With skill. <i>Fragments of a nearly complete jug <b>skillfully</b> restored at the institute of archaeology.</i>
<b><u>surly</u></b>	Bad-tempered and unfriendly. <i>A <b>surly</b> waiter.</i>
<b>willful</b>	Habitually disposed to disobedience and opposition. <i><b>Willful</b> disobedience.</i>
<b>willfully</b>	In a willful manner. <i>She had <b>willfully</b> deceived me.</i>
