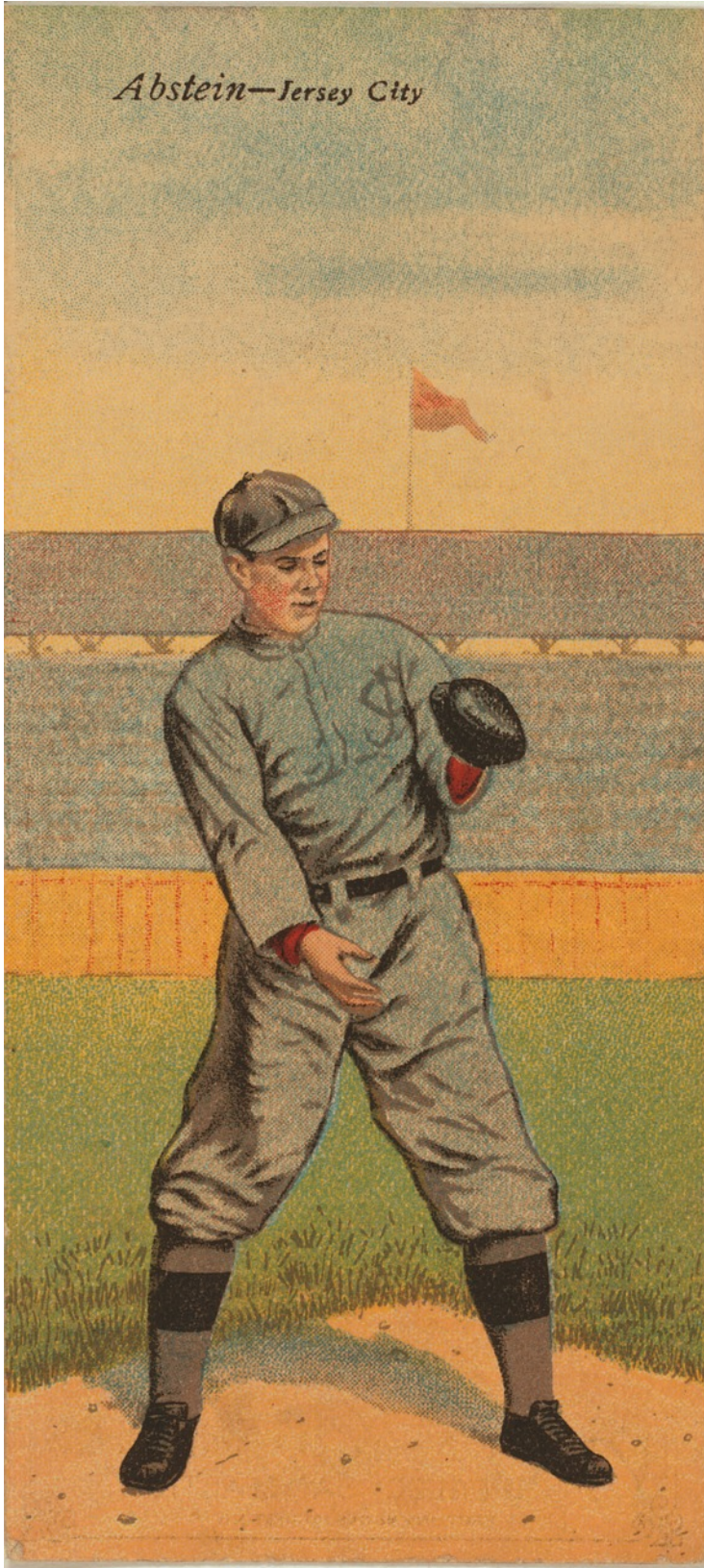
The synonyms of “Memorabilia” are: memento, keepsake, reminder, remembrance, token, memorial

Definitions of "Memorabilia" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “memorabilia” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A record of things worth remembering.*
- *Memorable or noteworthy observations or writings.*
- *Objects kept or collected because of their associations with memorable people or events.*



Synonyms of "Memorabilia" as a noun (6 Words)

keepsake	A small item kept in memory of the person who gave it or originally owned it. <i>She was wearing the medal he gave her as a keepsake.</i>
memento	A reminder of past events. <i>You can purchase a memento of your visit.</i>
<u>memorial</u>	A statement of facts, especially as the basis of a petition. <i>The Council sent a strongly worded memorial to the Chancellor of the Exchequer.</i>
remembrance	The action of remembering the dead. <i>I went through the papers and remembrances in his drawers.</i>
reminder	Someone who gives a warning so that a mistake can be avoided. <i>Her mushroom omelette is a blissful reminder of Sunday suppers.</i>
<u>token</u>	A badge or favour worn to indicate allegiance to a particular person or party. <i>I wanted to offer you a small token of my appreciation.</i>
