
Memorabilia as a Noun

Definitions of "Memorabilia" as a noun

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "memorabilia" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A record of things worth remembering.
- *Memorable or noteworthy observations or writings.*
- Objects kept or collected because of their associations with memorable people or events.







Synonyms of "Memorabilia" as a noun (6 Words)

A small item kept in memory of the person who gave it or originally owned

keepsake it.

She was wearing the medal he gave her as a **keepsake**.

memento

A reminder of past events.

You can purchase a **memento** of your visit.

A statement of facts, especially as the basis of a petition.

memorial

The Council sent a strongly worded **memorial** to the Chancellor of the

Exchequer.

party.

remembrance

The action of remembering the dead.

I went through the papers and **remembrance**s in his drawers.

reminder

Someone who gives a warning so that a mistake can be avoided. Her mushroom omelette is a blissful **reminder** of Sunday suppers.

token
