	Dealing with a subject in the abstract without practical purpose or
	intention. <i>A large <b>abstract</b> painting.</i>
academic	(of an institution or a course of study) placing a greater emphasis on reading and study than on technical or practical work. Ben is not an <b>academic</b> child but he tries hard.
<u>conceptual</u>	Being or characterized by concepts or their formation. The schizophrenic loses ability to abstract or do <b>conceptual</b> thinking.
<u>intellectual</u>	Involving intelligence rather than emotions or instinct. Satire is an <b>intellectual</b> weapon.
notional	(in language teaching) denoting or relating to a syllabus that aims to develop communicative competence. A <b>notional</b> figure of cost helps in determining production costs.
paranormal	Denoting events or phenomena such as telekinesis or clairvoyance that are beyond the scope of normal scientific understanding. <i>An investigator of the <b>paranormal</b>.</i>
philosophical	Relating or devoted to the study of the fundamental nature of knowledge, reality, and existence. <i>Philosophical</i> resignation.
speculative	(of an investment) involving a high risk of loss. <b>Speculative</b> knowledge.
<u>spiritual</u>	Resembling or characteristic of a phantom. The vital transcendental soul belonging to the <b>spiritual</b> realm.
supernatural	Unnaturally or extraordinarily great. <b>Supernatural</b> forces and occurrences and beings.
<u>theoretical</u>	Concerned primarily with theories or hypotheses rather than practical considerations. The <b>theoretical</b> value of their work.
transcendental	(of a function) not capable of being produced by the algebraical operations of addition, multiplication, and involution, or the inverse operations. The <b>transcendental</b> importance of each person s soul.
	The <b>transcention i</b> mportance of each person's sour.

aerodynamic	Of or relating to aerodynamics. The plane has a more <b>aerodynamic</b> shape.
chassis	The base frame of a car, carriage, or other wheeled vehicle.
conformation	Any spatial attributes (especially as defined by outline. A change of DNA <b>conformation</b> induced by binding of RNA polymerase.
contour	Mark a map or diagram with contour lines. It defines a major <b>contour</b> of this administration.
<u>embodied</u>	Possessing or existing in bodily form.
form	Bring or be brought into a certain formation. Essays in book <b>form</b> .
formation	Creation by mental activity. The <b>formation</b> of the Great Rift Valley.



<u>frame</u>	A framework that supports and protects a picture or a mirror. An utterance may mean the opposite of what it says if used within a <b>frame</b> of teasing.
framework	A structure supporting or containing something. Providing a factual <b>framework</b> for future research.
idea	An approximate calculation of quantity or degree or worth. The <b>idea</b> of the game is to capture all the pieces.
lattice	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. Honeysuckle was growing up a <b>lattice</b> round the door.
latticed	Having a pattern of fretwork or latticework. A <b>latticed</b> screen.
metaphysics	The philosophical study of being and knowing. They would regard the question of the initial conditions for the universe as belonging to the realm of <b>metaphysics</b> or religion.
<u>morph</u>	An image that has been morphed. The computer programmer <b>morph</b> ed the image.
morphological	Relating to the form or structure of things. <i>The geraniums have a number of unusual</i> <b>morphological</b> <i>adaptations.</i>
<u>morphology</u>	The branch of biology that deals with the form of living organisms, and with relationships between their structures. <i>Grammar is organized along two main dimensions</i> <b>morphology</b> <i>and</i> <i>syntax.</i>
multiform	Occurring in or having many forms or shapes or appearances. A very complex <b>multiform</b> illness like cancer.
pellet	Form a substance into pellets. <b>Pellet</b> ed forms of fertilizer.
polymorphous	Relating to the occurrence of more than one kind of individual (independent of sexual differences) in an interbreeding population. A <b>polymorphous</b> low grade tumour.
protuberant	Curving outward. His <b>protuberant</b> eyes fluttered open.
quadrate	Make square. The materials are there <b>quadrate</b> d or formed into rectangular blocks.
<u>round</u>	Express as a round number. The picture shows the pieces the wrong way <b>round</b> .
<u>shape</u>	Give a particular shape or form to. <i>Houseplants come in all <b>shape</b>s and sizes.</i>



spheroid	A solid generated by a half revolution of an ellipse about its major axis prolate spheroid or minor axis oblate spheroid. It looked like a sphere but on closer examination I saw it was really a <b>spheroid</b> .
<u>square</u>	Denoting a unit of measurement equal to the area of a square whose side is of the unit specified. <i>These lines must be</i> <b>square</b> <i>to the top and bottom marked edges.</i>
structural	Concerned with systematic structure in a particular field of study. The <b>structural</b> details of a house such as beams and joists and rafters not ornamental elements.
<u>syntax</u>	A set of rules for or an analysis of the syntax of a language. <i>Generative <b>synta</b>x</i> .
template	A nucleic acid molecule that acts as a pattern for the sequence of assembly of a protein, nucleic acid, or other large molecule. <i>Secondary structure in the template strand is eliminated.</i>
<u>theoretical</u>	Concerned with or involving the theory of a subject or area of study rather than its practical application. The training is practical rather than <b>theoretical</b> .
type	Determine the type to which a person or their blood or tissue belongs. The dolphin is a conventional <b>type</b> of Christ.
