<u>careful</u>	Cautiously attentive. <i>Careful</i> art restorers.
conscientious	Relating to a person's conscience. <b>Conscientious</b> application to the work at hand.
correct	Correct in opinion or judgment. <i>Correct</i> behavior.
demanding	(of a task) requiring much skill or effort. A baby can be so <b>demanding</b> .
diligent	Having or showing care and conscientiousness in one's work or duties. <i>After</i> <b>diligent</b> searching he found a parcel.



exacting	Having complicated nutritional requirements; especially growing only in special artificial cultures. <i>An <b>exacting</b> instructor.</i>
<u>painstaking</u>	Characterized by extreme care and great effort. <i>Painstaking</i> research.
punctilious	Marked by precise accordance with details. <b>Punctilious</b> in his attention to rules of etiquette.
scrupulous	Having scruples; arising from a sense of right and wrong; principled.

<u>assiduous</u>	Marked by care and persistent effort. Her <b>assiduous</b> attempts to learn French.
<u>busy</u>	Unavailable for use by anyone else or indicating unavailability engaged is a British term for a busy telephone line. The team members are <b>busy</b> raising money.
<u>careful</u>	Unhurried and with care and dignity. <i>Careful</i> of the rights of others.
conscientious	Guided by or in accordance with conscience or sense of right and wrong. <i>Conscientious application to the work at hand.</i>
detailed	(of a work of art) executed with many minor decorative features. More <b>detailed</b> information was needed.
<u>diligence</u>	Careful and persistent work or effort. <i>His <b>diligence</b> won him quick promotions.</i>
diligent	Quietly and steadily persevering especially in detail or exactness. <i>After</i> <b>diligent</b> searching he found a parcel.
<u>exact</u>	Demand and obtain (something) from someone. An <b>exact</b> copy.
exacting	Having complicated nutritional requirements; especially growing only in special artificial cultures. An <b>exacting</b> job.
exactitude	Care and attention to detail. <i>He writes with <b>exactitude</b> and precision.</i>
<u>fastidious</u>	Giving careful attention to detail; hard to please; excessively concerned with cleanliness. <i>Fastidious</i> about personal cleanliness.
<u>finicky</u>	(of a person) fussy about their needs or requirements. A <b>finicky</b> eater.
fussy	Annoyed and irritable. I hate <b>fussy</b> clothes.
hardworking	Characterized by hard work and perseverance.
<u>industrious</u>	Working hard to promote an enterprise. An <b>industrious</b> people striving to make their country prosperous.



<u>painstaking</u>	Characterized by extreme care and great effort. <i>Painstaking</i> research.
painstakingly	With great care and thoroughness. The property has been <b>painstakingly</b> restored by its current owners.
pedantic	Marked by a narrow focus on or display of learning especially its trivial aspects. His analyses are careful and even painstaking but never <b>pedantic</b> .
<u>picky</u>	Exacting especially about details. They are becoming increasingly <b>picky</b> about where they stay.
plodding	Slow and laborious. A <b>plodding</b> comedy drama.
<u>precise</u>	(of a person) exact, accurate, and careful about details. A <b>precise</b> measurement.
priggish	Self-righteously moralistic and superior. A <b>priggish</b> little pedant.
prissy	Exaggeratedly proper. A middle class family with two <b>prissy</b> children.
puritanical	Of or relating to Puritans or Puritanism. His <b>puritanical</b> parents saw any kind of pleasure as the road to damnation.
scrupulous	Characterized by extreme care and great effort. Less <b>scrupulous</b> producers sent bundles that were deceptive in appearance.
sedulous	Marked by care and persistent effort. <i>He watched himself with the most <b>sedulous</b> care.</i>
stickler	Someone who insists on something. I m a <b>stickler</b> when it comes to timekeeping.
<u>studious</u>	Spending a lot of time studying or reading. <i>He was quiet and <b>studious</b>.</i>
working	(of parts of a machine) moving and causing a machine to operate. <i>Working</i> with animals teaches patience.
