Painstaking research.

painstakingly With great care and thoroughness.

The property has been **painstakingly** restored by its current owners.

Marked by a narrow focus on or display of learning especially its trivial

pedantic aspects.

His analyses are careful and even painstaking but never **pedantic**.

Exacting especially about details.

They are becoming increasingly **picky** about where they stay.

Slow and laborious.

plodding
