<b>amply</b>	To an ample degree or in an ample manner. <i>The evidence <b>amply</b> or fully confirms our suspicions.</i>
<b>carefully</b>	In a way that deliberately avoids harm or errors; cautiously. <i>They must be <b>carefully</b> handled and stored.</i>
<b>conscientious</b>	Characterized by extreme care and great effort. <i>A <b>conscientious</b> man he took his duties very seriously.</i>
<b>detailed</b>	Developed or executed with care and in minute detail. <i>More <b>detailed</b> information was needed.</i>
<b>discography</b>	A descriptive catalogue of musical recordings, particularly those of a particular performer or composer. <i>Jazz fans direct their intellectual energy to <b>discography</b>.</i>
<b>elaborate</b>	Developed or executed with care and in minute detail. <i><b>Elaborate</b> wrought iron gates.</i>
<b>elaboration</b>	A discussion that provides additional information. <i>The concept needs more <b>elaboration</b> than a short essay allows.</i>
<b>exact</b>	Marked by strict and particular and complete accordance with fact. <i>The <b>exact</b> details were still being worked out.</i>
<b>exactitude</b>	The quality of being exact. <i>It is not possible to say with any scientific <b>exactitude</b> what a dream means.</i>
<b>exegetis</b>	Critical explanation or interpretation of a text, especially of scripture. <i>The task of biblical <b>exegetis</b>.</i>
<b>fastidious</b>	Very attentive to and concerned about accuracy and detail. <i>The child seemed <b>fastidious</b> about getting her fingers dirty.</i>
<b>instructions</b>	A manual usually accompanying a technical device and explaining how to install or operate it.
<b>intricacy</b>	Marked by elaborately complex detail. <i>The <b>intricacy</b> of the procedure.</i>

<b>involution</b>	Marked by elaborately complex detail. <i>Periods of artistic <b>involution</b>.</i>
<b>labyrinth</b>	A complex structure in the inner ear which contains the organs of hearing and balance It consists of bony cavities the bony labyrinth filled with fluid and lined with sensitive membranes the membranous labyrinth. <i>You lose yourself in a <b>labyrinth</b> of little streets.</i>
<b>lapidary</b>	A skilled worker who cuts and engraves precious stones. <i>A <b>lapidary</b> statement.</i>
<b>maze</b>	A network of paths and hedges designed as a puzzle through which one has to find a way. <i>A <b>maze</b> of petty regulations.</i>
<b>meticulous</b>	Marked by precise accordance with details. <i>The designs are hand glazed with <b>meticulous</b> care.</i>
<b>minute</b>	The distance covered in a minute by someone driving or walking. <i>We waited for twenty <b>minutes</b>.</i>
<b>nicety</b>	Accuracy or precision. <i>She prided herself on her <b>nicety</b> of pronunciation.</i>
<b>painstaking</b>	Done with or employing great care and thoroughness. <i>He is a gentle <b>painstaking</b> man.</i>
<b>painstakingly</b>	With great care and thoroughness. <i>It is almost a waste of time <b>painstakingly</b> to learn the routines of selling.</i>
<b>pedantic</b>	Marked by a narrow focus on or display of learning especially its trivial aspects. <i>His analyses are careful and even painstaking but never <b>pedantic</b>.</i>
<b>peruse</b>	Examine or consider with attention and in detail. <i>Laura <b>perused</b> a Caravaggio.</i>
<b>precise</b>	Marked by exactness and accuracy of expression or detail. <i>A <b>precise</b> image.</i>
<b>precisely</b>	Exactly (used to emphasize the complete accuracy or truth of a statement). <i>He was doing <b>precisely</b> or exactly what she had told him to do.</i>
<b>punctilious</b>	Marked by precise accordance with details. <i>He was <b>punctilious</b> in providing every amenity for his guests.</i>
<b>scriptural</b>	Of or pertaining to or contained in or in accordance with the Bible. <i><b>Scriptural</b> quotations from Genesis.</i>
<b>scrupulous</b>	(of a person or process) careful, thorough, and extremely attentive to details. <i><b>Scrupulous</b> attention to details.</i>
