Definitions of "Middleman" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “middleman” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A person who arranges business or political deals between other people.*
- *A person who buys goods from producers and sells them to retailers or consumers.*
- *A person who is in a position to give you special assistance.*
- *Someone who buys large quantities of goods and resells to merchants rather than to the ultimate customers.*
- *The performer in the middle of a minstrel line who engages the others in talk.*



Synonyms of "Middleman" as a noun (6 Words)

- contact** Electronics a junction where things as two electrical conductors touch or are in physical contact.
*He used his business **contacts** to get an introduction to the governor.*
- go-between** A negotiator who acts as a link between parties.
- interlocutor** The performer in the middle of a minstrel line who engages the others in talk.
- intermediary** A person who acts as a link between people in order to try and bring about an agreement; a mediator.
*Negotiations took place through an **intermediary**.*
- jobber** Someone who buys large quantities of goods and resells to merchants rather than to the ultimate customers.
- wholesaler** A person or company that sells goods in large quantities at low prices, typically to retailers.
*The largest pharmaceuticals **wholesaler** in the country.*



Usage Examples of "Middleman" as a noun

- *We maintain value for money by cutting out the middleman and selling direct.*
