Definitions of "Middleman" as a noun

- *A person who arranges business or political deals between other people.*
- *A person who buys goods from producers and sells them to retailers or consumers.*
- *A person who is in a position to give you special assistance.*
- *Someone who buys large quantities of goods and resells to merchants rather than to the ultimate customers.*
- *The performer in the middle of a minstrel line who engages the others in talk.*



Synonyms of "Middleman" as a noun (6 Words)

contact	Electronics a junction where things as two electrical conductors touch or are in physical contact. <i>He used his business contacts to get an introduction to the governor.</i>
go-between	A negotiator who acts as a link between parties.
interlocutor	The performer in the middle of a minstrel line who engages the others in talk.
intermediary	A person who acts as a link between people in order to try and bring about an agreement; a mediator. <i>Negotiations took place through an intermediary.</i>
jobber	Someone who buys large quantities of goods and resells to merchants rather than to the ultimate customers.
wholesaler	A person or company that sells goods in large quantities at low prices, typically to retailers. <i>The largest pharmaceuticals wholesaler in the country.</i>
