- Requiring little mental effort.
- Acting or done without justification and with no concern for the consequences.
- Not mindful or attentive.
- (of an activity) so simple or repetitive as to be performed automatically.

half-witted Retarded in intellectual development.

heedless of Marked by or paying little heed or attention-Franklin D. Roosevelt.

idiotic Very stupid.

I was able to hum its **idiotic** theme tune.



imbecile Stupid; idiotic.

Try not to make **imbecile** remarks.

imbecilic Having a mental age of three to seven years.

indifferent to Having only a limited ability to react chemically; chemically inactive.

indiscriminate Failing to make or recognize distinctions.

The **indiscriminate** use of antibiotics can cause problems.

insensible to Unresponsive to stimulation.

mechanical (of an action) done without thought or spontaneity; automatic.

A mechanical device.

obtuse Lacking in insight or discernment- Jasper Griffin.

It had strange **obtuse** teeth.

reasonless Not endowed with the capacity to reason.

An apparently arbitrary and **reasonless** change.

robotic Resembling the unthinking functioning of a machine.

His **robotic** voice.

routine Found in the ordinary course of events.

The Ministry insisted that this was just a **routine** annual drill.

senseless Lacking sense or understanding or judgment.

The attack left a policeman beaten **senseless**.

slow-witted Retarded in intellectual development.

Showing lack of careful thought.

thoughtless The **thoughtless** saying of a great princess on being informed that the

unaware of Not aware.

unintelligent

Having or showing a low level of intelligence.

A dull job with lazy and **unintelligent** co workers.

unmindful Not conscious or aware.
