Ming in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I am minging	We are minging
You are minging	You are minging
He/She/It is minging	They are minging

Ming in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural

I have minged, meint, or ment	We have minged, meint, or ment
You have minged, meint, or ment	You have minged, meint, or ment
He/She/It has minged, meint, or ment	They have minged, meint, or ment

Ming in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I have been minging	We have been minging
You have been minging	You have been minging
He/She/It has been minging	They have been minging
