Definitions of "Minimal" as an adjective

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "minimal" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Characterized by the repetition and gradual alteration of short phrases.
- (of a pair of forms) distinguished by only one feature.
- Characterized by simplicity and lack of adornment or decoration.
- Characterized by the use of simple forms or structures, especially geometric or massive ones.
- Of a minimum amount, quantity, or degree; negligible.
- The least possible.





Synonyms of "Minimal" as an adjective (3 Words)


minimum Smallest or lowest.

very little Being the exact same one; not any other.





Usage Examples of "Minimal" as an adjective

- The aircraft suffered minimal damage.
- Her grades were minimal.
- Minimal, simple evening dresses in luxurious fabrics.
- A minimal charge for the service.
- 'p' and 'b' are a minimal pair, distinguished by the feature of voicing.
- Production costs are minimal.
- Needed to enforce minimal standards.

miniature Being on a very small scale.

minimum Smallest or lowest.

They checked visas with the **minimum** of fuss.

Of a key or mode based on a minor scale and tending to produce a sad or

minor pensive effect.

Jones **minor**.

negligible So small or unimportant as to be not worth considering; insignificant.

He said that the risks were **negligible**.

peccadillo A petty misdeed.

The sexual **peccadillo**es of celebrities aren t necessarily news.

pettiness Lack of generosity in trifling matters.

The sheer **pettiness** of the officials was quite startling.

several Applied or regarded separately.

slightly The children argued because one slice of cake was **slightly** larger than the

small Into small pieces.

A **small** car.

tiny Very small.

trifling Not worth considering.
