

mini	Denoting a miniature version of something. A mini camera.
miniature	A copy that reproduces a person or thing in greatly reduced size. <i>Children dressed as miniature adults.</i>
<u>minimal</u>	Characterized by the use of simple forms or structures, especially geometric or massive ones. A minimal charge for the service.
<u>minor</u>	Of a key or mode based on a minor scale and tending to produce a sad or pensive effect. Salinas was one of six teams in the minor s.
minuscule	Minuscule script. A minuscule amount of rain fell.
missive	A document in the form of a letter exchanged by the parties to a contract. <i>Yet another missive from the Foreign Office.</i>
peccadillo	A relatively minor fault or sin. The sexual peccadillo es of celebrities aren t necessarily news.



pettiness	Lack of generosity in trifling matters. These awesome moments lift us above the pettiness of the world.
pinprick	A minor annoyance or irritation. Compared with the indignities he had so far endured this was a mere pinprick .
puny	Of inferior size. White faced puny children.
remotely	In a remote manner. A new type of remotely controlled torpedo.
slight	A deliberate discourteous act (usually as an expression of anger or disapproval. A Council determined whether the Fort should be kept or slight ed.
small	Have fine or very small constituent particles. They are diehard conservatives with a small c.
smattering	A slight superficial knowledge of a language or subject. A smattering of snow.
tiny	Very small. A tiny hummingbird.
trifling	Not worth considering. A trifling sum.
<u>trivial</u>	Concerned with trivialities. A trivial young woman.
undersized	Of less than the usual size. The undersized cubs may not survive the winter.
wee	(used informally) very small. The lyrics are a wee bit too s wee t and sentimental.
