**diminutive** A diminutive word or suffix.

<b>fancier</b>	A person having a strong liking for something. <i>A pigeon <b>fancier</b>.</i>
<b><u>handful</u></b>	A quantity that fills the hand. <i>The kids could be such a <b>handful</b>.</i>
<b>iota</b>	The 9th letter of the Greek alphabet. <i>Nothing she said seemed to make an <b>iota</b> of difference.</i>
<b>least</b>	Used in names of very small animals and plants e g least shrew. <i>It is the <b>least</b> I can do.</i>
<b><u>less</u></b>	Lower in quality. <i>A shower uses <b>less</b> water.</i>
<b>letter</b>	Mark letters on or mark with letters. <i>He numbered and <b>lettered</b> the paragraphs.</i>
<b>lilliputian</b>	Small and of little importance. <i>A <b>lilliputian</b> chest of drawers.</i>
<b><u>literacy</u></b>	The ability to read and write. <i>Adult <b>literacy</b> programmes.</i>
<b>little</b>	Used in names of animals and plants that are smaller than related kinds e g little grebe. <i>What a nasty <b>little</b> situation.</i>
<b>mini</b>	Denoting a miniature version of something. <i>A <b>mini</b> camera.</i>
<b>miniature</b>	A copy that reproduces a person or thing in greatly reduced size. <i>Children dressed as <b>miniature</b> adults.</i>
<b><u>minimal</u></b>	Characterized by the use of simple forms or structures, especially geometric or massive ones. <i>A <b>minimal</b> charge for the service.</i>
<b><u>minor</u></b>	Of a key or mode based on a minor scale and tending to produce a sad or pensive effect. <i>Salinas was one of six teams in the <b>minors</b>.</i>
<b>minuscule</b>	Minuscule script. <i>A <b>minuscule</b> amount of rain fell.</i>
<b>missive</b>	A document in the form of a letter exchanged by the parties to a contract. <i>Yet another <b>missive</b> from the Foreign Office.</i>
<b>peccadillo</b>	A relatively minor fault or sin. <i>The sexual <b>peccadilloes</b> of celebrities aren't necessarily news.</i>

<b>pettiness</b>	Lack of generosity in trifling matters. <i>These awesome moments lift us above the <b>pettiness</b> of the world.</i>
<b>pinprick</b>	A minor annoyance or irritation. <i>Compared with the indignities he had so far endured this was a mere <b>pinprick</b>.</i>
<b>puny</b>	Of inferior size. <i>White faced <b>puny</b> children.</i>
<b>remotely</b>	In a remote manner. <i>A new type of <b>remotely</b> controlled torpedo.</i>
<b>slight</b>	A deliberate discourteous act (usually as an expression of anger or disapproval). <i>A Council determined whether the Fort should be kept or <b>slighted</b>.</i>
<b>small</b>	Have fine or very small constituent particles. <i>They are diehard conservatives with a <b>small</b> c.</i>
<b>smattering</b>	A slight superficial knowledge of a language or subject. <i>A <b>smattering</b> of snow.</i>
<b>tiny</b>	Very small. <i>A <b>tiny</b> hummingbird.</i>
<b>trifling</b>	Not worth considering. <i>A <b>trifling</b> sum.</i>
<b>trivial</b>	Concerned with trivialities. <i>A <b>trivial</b> young woman.</i>
<b>undersized</b>	Of less than the usual size. <i>The <b>undersized</b> cubs may not survive the winter.</i>
<b>wee</b>	(used informally) very small. <i>The lyrics are a <b>wee</b> bit too <b>sweet</b> and sentimental.</i>
