Infinitive	<b>to misfashion</b>
Present Tense	<b>misfashion / misfashions</b>
Past Tense	<b>misfashioned</b>
Present Participle	<b>misfashioning</b>
Past Participle	<b>misfashioned</b>

## **Conjugate Misfashion**

**Misfashion in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>misfashion</b>	We <b>misfashion</b>
You <b>misfashion</b>	You <b>misfashion</b>
He/She/It <b>misfashions</b>	They <b>misfashion</b>

### **Misfashion in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am misfashioning</b>	We <b>are misfashioning</b>
You <b>are misfashioning</b>	You <b>are misfashioning</b>
He/She/It <b>is misfashioning</b>	They <b>are misfashioning</b>

### **Misfashion in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have misfashioned</b>	We <b>have misfashioned</b>
You <b>have misfashioned</b>	You <b>have misfashioned</b>
He/She/It <b>has misfashioned</b>	They <b>have misfashioned</b>

### **Misfashion in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been misfashioning</b>	We <b>have been misfashioning</b>
You <b>have been misfashioning</b>	You <b>have been misfashioning</b>
He/She/It <b>has been misfashioning</b>	They <b>have been misfashioning</b>

### **Misfashion in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>misfashioned</b>	We <b>misfashioned</b>
You <b>misfashioned</b>	You <b>misfashioned</b>
He/She/It <b>misfashioned</b>	They <b>misfashioned</b>

### **Misfashion in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was misfashioning      We were misfashioning  
You were misfashioning      You were misfashioning  
He/She/It was misfashioning      They were misfashioning

**Misfashion in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had misfashioned      We had misfashioned  
You had misfashioned      You had misfashioned  
He/She/It had misfashioned      They had misfashioned

**Misfashion in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been misfashioning      We had been misfashioning  
You had been misfashioning      You had been misfashioning  
He/She/It had been misfashioning      They had been misfashioning

**Misfashion in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will misfashion      We will misfashion  
You will misfashion      You will misfashion  
He/She/It will misfashion      They will misfashion

**Misfashion in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be misfashioning      We will be misfashioning  
You will be misfashioning      You will be misfashioning  
He/She/It will be misfashioning      They will be misfashioning

**Misfashion in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have misfashioned**

**We will have misfashioned**

**You will have misfashioned**

**You will have misfashioned**

**He/She/It will have misfashioned**

**They will have misfashioned**

**Misfashion in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been misfashioning**

**We will have been misfashioning**

**You will have been misfashioning**

**You will have been misfashioning**

**He/She/It will have been misfashioning**

**They will have been misfashioning**
