The speech act of contradicting someone.

**contradiction** The proposed new system suffers from a set of internal

contradictions.

A chord which (in conventional harmonic terms) is regarded as

unpleasing or requiring resolution by another.

A prosperous family who showed no signs of **discord**.

An illogical or surprising lack of compatibility or similarity between

**discrepancy** two or more facts.

There s a discrepancy between your account and his.



**incongruity**The state of being incongruous; incompatibility.

The **incongruity** of his fleshy face and skinny body disturbed her.

**incongruousness** The quality of disagreeing; being unsuitable and inappropriate.

The relation between propositions that cannot both be true at the

same time.

inconsistency
The inconsistency between his expressed attitudes and his actual

behaviour.

**lack of congruence** The state of needing something that is absent or unavailable.

misalliance An unsuitable alliance (especially with regard to marriage.

It s no good blaming yourself it was a hopeless **misalliance**.

**mismarriage** An unsuitable marriage or alliance.

**mésalliance** A marriage with a person of inferior social status.
