## Mismatch as a Noun

### Definitions of "Mismatch" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “mismatch” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A bad or unsuitable match.*
- *An unequal or unfair sporting contest.*
- *A failure to correspond or match; a discrepancy.*



## Synonyms of "Mismatch" as a noun (12 Words)

<b>bad match</b>	That which is below standard or expectations as of ethics or decency.
<b>conflict</b>	An open clash between two opposing groups (or individuals)-Thomas Paine. <i>He was immobilized by <b>conflict</b> and indecision.</i>
<b><u>contradiction</u></b>	The speech act of contradicting someone. <i>The proposed new system suffers from a set of internal <b>contradictions</b>.</i>
<b><u>discord</u></b>	A chord which (in conventional harmonic terms) is regarded as unpleasing or requiring resolution by another. <i>A prosperous family who showed no signs of <b>discord</b>.</i>
<b>discrepancy</b>	An illogical or surprising lack of compatibility or similarity between two or more facts. <i>There s a <b>discrepancy</b> between your account and his.</i>

<b>incongruity</b>	The state of being incongruous; incompatibility. <i>The <b>incongruity</b> of his fleshy face and skinny body disturbed her.</i>
<b>incongruousness</b>	The quality of disagreeing; being unsuitable and inappropriate. The relation between propositions that cannot both be true at the same time. <i>The <b>incongruity</b> between his expressed attitudes and his actual behaviour.</i>
<b>lack of congruence</b>	The state of needing something that is absent or unavailable.
<b>misalliance</b>	An unsuitable alliance (especially with regard to marriage). <i>It s no good blaming yourself it was a hopeless <b>misalliance</b>.</i>
<b>mismatch</b>	An unsuitable marriage or alliance.
<b>mésalliance</b>	A marriage with a person of inferior social status.



### Usage Examples of "Mismatch" as a noun

- *There are fewer mismatches so spectators get better value for money.*
- *A huge mismatch between supply and demand.*
