Children die from neglect or are **maltreat**ed by their carers.

Showing no mercy. merciless

Gave him a **merciless** beating.

Treat (someone or something) badly or unfairly.

The director of the factory **misuse**d the funds intended for the health care of misuse

his workers.

Imitate with mockery and derision. mock

Jim threw up his hands in **mock** horror.

Keep (someone) in subjection and hardship, especially by the unjust exercise

of authority. **oppress** 

The government **oppress**es political activists.

parricide A person who commits parricide.

Harass or annoy (someone) persistently. persecute

His followers were **persecute**d by the authorities.

Someone who torments. persecutor

A well known curmudgeon and **persecutor** of buskers.

In an unceasingly intense or harsh way. relentlessly

Having or showing no pity or compassion for others.

ruthless A **ruthless** manipulator.

Deriving pleasure or sexual gratification from inflicting pain on another. sadistic

A **sadistic** killer.

Marked by eagerness to resort to violence and bloodshed. sanguinary

Torment emotionally or mentally. torment
