Definitions of "Modality" as a noun

- *Verb inflections that express how the action or state is conceived by the speaker.*
- *A particular form of sensory perception.*
- *A particular method or procedure.*
- *A particular mode in which something exists or is experienced or expressed.*
- *A particular sense.*
- *A method of therapy that involves physical or electrical therapeutic treatment.*
- *A classification of propositions on the basis of whether they claim necessity or possibility or impossibility.*
- *Modal quality.*



Synonyms of "Modality" as a noun (3 Words)

mode

An option allowing a change in the method of operation of a device, especially a camera.

*A camcorder in automatic **mode**.*

mood

The prevailing psychological state.

*The national **mood** had changed radically since the last election.*

sense modality A natural appreciation or ability.



Usage Examples of "Modality" as a noun

- *The visual and auditory modalities.*
- *The harmony had a touch of modality.*
- *The modalities of troop withdrawals.*
