fond Having an affection or liking for.

He was not too **fond** of dancing.

Marked by moderate steepness.

Gentle rain.

kind Agreeable, conducive to comfort.

Thanked her for her **kind** letter.

kindly Showing or motivated by sympathy and understanding and generosity.

He was a quiet **kindly** man.

loving Enjoying the specified activity or thing.

Her music loving son.

maternal (of feelings) typical of a caring mother; motherly.

Maternal care.

maternalistic Relating to or derived from one's mother.

Intended to protect someone or something.

Protective gloves are worn to minimize injury.

Inclined to heel over easily under sail.

tender

Pelargoniums are colourful but **tender** plants.

Characterized by understanding based on comprehension and

understanding discernment and empathy.

People expect their doctor to be **understanding**.

warm Psychologically warm friendly and responsive.

Her fair colouring suited soft **warm** shades.
