
Muffled as an Adjective

<u>buffer</u>	Add a buffer a solution. Print speed is boosted by pages being formatted in a buffer while another is printing.
chocolate	A sweet made of or covered with chocolate. A chocolate biscuit.
clement	(of a person or their actions) merciful. It is a very clement day.
<u>conspire</u>	Engage in plotting or enter into a conspiracy, swear together. <i>They</i> conspire d against him.



<u>covered</u>	Overlaid or spread or topped with or enclosed within something; sometimes used as a combining form. Women with covered faces.
<u>drenched</u>	Abundantly covered or supplied with; often used in combination. Drenched in moonlight.
<u>dusty</u>	Covered with a layer of dust. A dusty pile of books.
elasticity	Ability to change and adapt; adaptability. Aging can decrease the elasticity of your skin.
fluffy	Of, like, or covered with fluff. <i>Fluffy</i> white clouds.
<u>fuzzy</u>	Confused and not coherent; not clearly thought out. <i>The picture is very fuzzy</i> .
<u>hidden</u>	Not accessible to view. A hidden cave.
hide	Be or go into hiding; keep out of sight, as for protection and safety. <i>Herbert could hardly hide his dislike</i> .
mellow	In a mellow manner. To most farmers soil has good tilth when it is mellow and granular and crumbles easily in the hand.
moisturize	Make (something, especially the skin) less dry. <i>Revitalize your face moisturize your skin.</i>
muted	(of a musical instrument) having a muffled sound as a result of being fitted with a mute. <i>Muted</i> anger.
pigskin	Leather made from pigskin. A pair of black pigskin gloves.
quiet	With little or no activity or no agitation quiet is a nonstandard variant for quietly. We wanted a quiet wedding.
rolling	Propelling something on wheels. He was charged with rolling drunks in the park.
secretly	In secrecy; not openly. I was embarrassed but secretly pleased too.
<u>sliding</u>	Being a smooth continuous motion. <i>Sliding</i> TV ratings.



snow	Falls of snow. The first snow s of winter.
snowball	Throw snowballs at. The campaign was snowball ing.
snowy	(of weather or a period of time) characterized by snowfall. A long snowy winter.
soft	Used chiefly as a direction or description in music soft in a quiet subdued tone. Soft data.
stealthily	In a cautious and surreptitious manner, so as not to be seen or heard. We need to move stealthily and look inconspicuous.
subdued	Not brilliant or glaring. I felt strangely subdued as I drove home.
velvety	Smooth and soft to sight or hearing or touch or taste. Robes of velvety black.
<u>whisper</u>	A soft or confidential tone of voice a whispered word or phrase. <i>He managed to whisper a faint goodbye.</i>
whispering	Speaking softly without vibration of the vocal cords.
white	Of wine made from white grapes or dark grapes with the skins removed and having a yellowish colour. <i>He was dressed from head to foot in white.</i>
