Associations of "Multifaceted s" (30 Words)

assorted	Consisting of a haphazard assortment of different kinds. Assorted sizes.
assortment	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>A great assortment of cars was on display.</i>
classification	The arrangement of animals and plants in taxonomic groups according to their observed similarities (including at least kingdom and phylum in animals, division in plants, and class, order, family, genus, and species. <i>The classification of disease according to symptoms.</i>
dissimilar	Marked by dissimilarity. <i>A group of very dissimilar people.</i>
diverse	Showing a great deal of variety; very different. <i>Subjects as diverse as architecture language teaching and the physical sciences.</i>
diversity	The practice or quality of including or involving people from a range of different social and ethnic backgrounds and of different genders, sexual orientations, etc. <i>Equality and diversity should be supported for their own sake.</i>
eclectic	Someone who selects according to the eclectic method. <i>Universities offering an eclectic mix of courses.</i>
heterogeneous	Incommensurable through being of different kinds, degrees, or dimensions. Heterogeneous catalysis.
hexagon	A plane figure with six straight sides and angles.
itemize	Present as a list of individual items. <i>An itemized bill.</i>
manifold	A pipe or chamber branching into several openings. <i>Our manifold failings.</i>

miscellaneous	Having many aspects or qualities. A miscellaneous collection of well known ne er do wells.
miscellany	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. A miscellany of houses.
mixed	Composed of different varieties of the same thing. A mixed neighborhood.
motley	A garment made of motley especially a court jester s costume. Life size mannequins in full motley .
multifarious	Having many varied parts or aspects. A vast multifarious organization.
multiplicity	A large number. The demand for higher education depends on a multiplicity of factors.
numerous	Great in number; many. The orchestra and chorus were numerous .
octagon	An object or building with an octagonal plan or cross section.
pastiche	An artistic work in a style that imitates that of another work, artist, or period. A pastiche of literary models and sources.
pluralism	The practice of holding more than one ecclesiastical office at a time.
polygon	A plane figure with at least three straight sides and angles, and typically five or more.
potpourri	A mixture or medley of things. He played a potpourri of tunes from Gilbert and Sullivan.
protean	Taking on different forms. Eyes of that baffling protean grey which is never twice the same.
sundry	Various items not important enough to be mentioned individually. Sundry sciences commonly known as social.
type	Determine the type to which a person or their blood or tissue belongs. The word element contains five different types of character.
varied	Incorporating a number of different types or elements; showing variation or variety. Her quickly varied answers indicated uncertainty.
variety	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. A variety show.
various	Distinctly dissimilar or unlike. His disguises are many and various .
