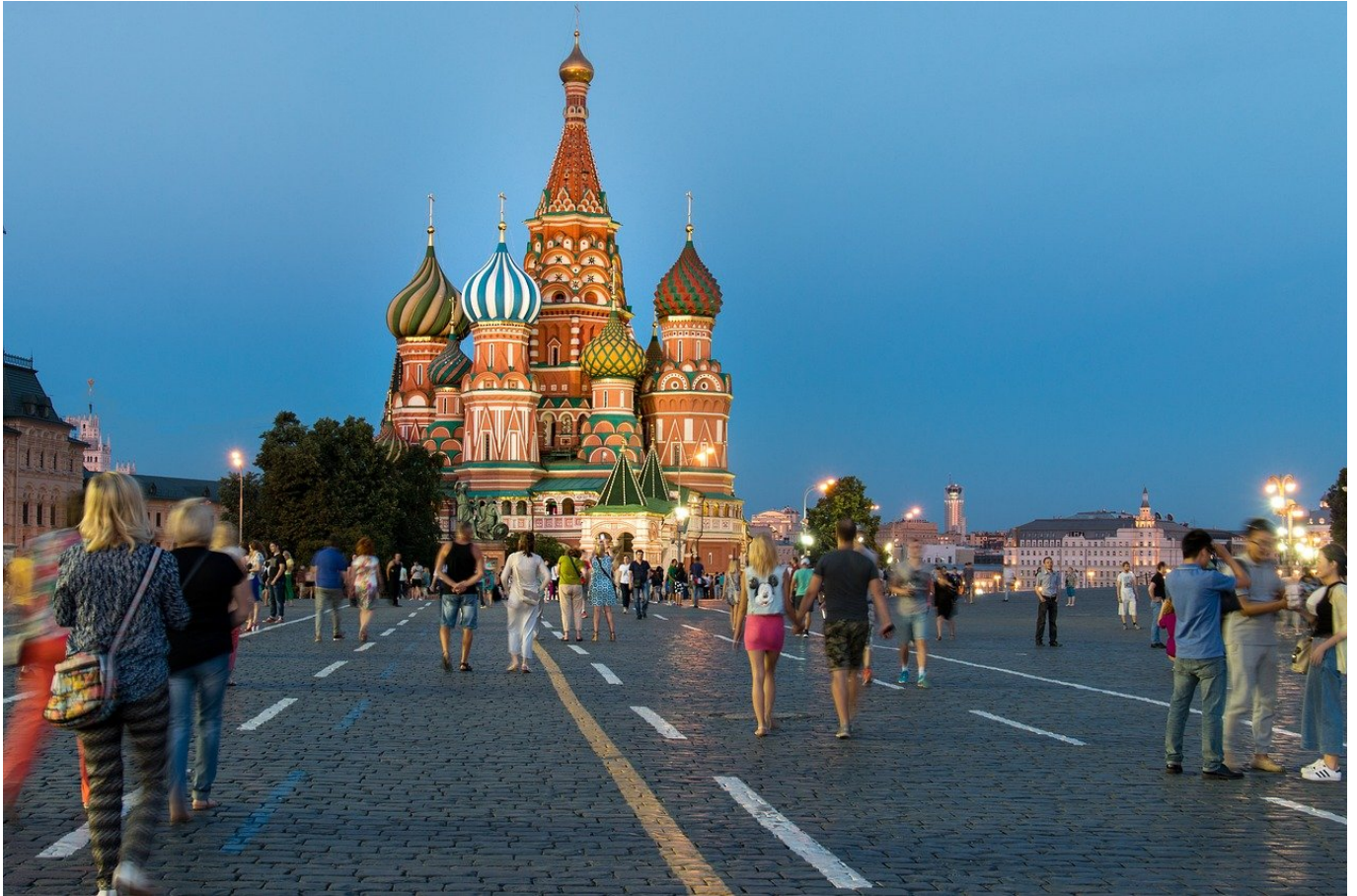

## **Museum as a Noun**

### **Definitions of "Museum" as a noun**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “museum” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A building in which objects of historical, scientific, artistic, or cultural interest are stored and exhibited.*
- *A depository for collecting and displaying objects having scientific or historical or artistic value.*



## Synonyms of "Museum" as a noun (4 Words)

**chancery** A public record office.

**record office** A document that can serve as legal evidence of a transaction.

**registry** An official written record of names or events or transactions.  
*MI5 maintains a large **registry** of files on individuals and organizations.*

**repository** A place where or receptacle in which things are or may be stored.  
*The metadata will be aggregated in a **repository**.*



## Usage Examples of "Museum" as a noun

- *A museum curator.*
- *The museum is noted for its fine fossil collection.*
- *It is difficult to avoid the feeling that the city is now a living museum.*
- *The Museum of Modern Art.*



## Associations of "Museum" (30 Words)

- archive** Place or store something in an archive.  
*Source materials in local **archives**.*
- archives** Collection of records especially about an institution.
- archivist** A person who maintains and is in charge of archives.
- carve** Cut (a hard material) in order to produce an object, design, or inscription.  
*The company has **carved** a name for itself in the smartphone market.*
- curator** The custodian of a collection (as a museum or library).  
*The **curator** of drawings at the National Gallery.*
- demonstrate** Provide evidence for; stand as proof of; show by one's behavior, attitude, or external attributes.  
*Computerized design methods will be **demonstrated**.*
- depository** A facility where things can be deposited for storage or safekeeping.  
*Irish libraries became **depositories** for material from all over the world.*

<b>dinosaur</b>	Any of numerous extinct terrestrial reptiles of the Mesozoic era.
<b><u>document</u></b>	Support or accompany with documentation. <i>Can you <b>document</b> your claims.</i>
<b>effigy</b>	A sculpture or model of a person. <i>Angry campaigners plan to burn an <b>effigy</b> of the social security minister.</i>
<b>emboss</b>	Raise in a relief. <i><b>Embossed</b> stationery.</i>
<b>exhibit</b>	Give an exhibition of to an interested audience. <i>She was invited to <b>exhibit</b> at several French museums.</i>
<b>extinction</b>	The act of extinguishing; causing to stop burning. <i>Mass <b>extinctions</b>.</i>
<b>inscription</b>	A short message (as in a book or musical work or on a photograph) dedicating it to someone or something. <i>The <b>inscription</b> on her headstone.</i>
<b><u>librarian</u></b>	A person in charge of or assisting in a library.
<b><u>library</u></b>	A collection of books and periodicals held in a library. <i>A record <b>library</b>.</i>
<b><u>memorial</u></b>	A record or memoir. <i>A <b>memorial</b> to General Robert E Lee.</i>
<b><u>monolithic</u></b>	Formed of a single large block of stone. <i>A <b>monolithic</b> society.</i>
<b><u>monument</u></b>	A statue, building, or other structure erected to commemorate a notable person or event. <i>A <b>monument</b> to Magellan is in the main square of the city.</i>
<b>monumental</b>	Relating or belonging to or serving as a monument. <i>Einstein s <b>monumental</b> contributions to physics.</i>
<b><u>preserve</u></b>	Fruit preserved by cooking with sugar. <i><b>Preserved</b> meats.</i>
<b>pterodactyl</b>	A pterosaur of the late Jurassic period, with a long slender head and neck and a very short tail.
<b>record</b>	Sound recording consisting of a disk with a continuous groove used to reproduce music by rotating while a phonograph needle tracks in the groove. <i>The lawyer has a good <b>record</b>.</i>
<b>repository</b>	A person to whom a secret is entrusted. <i>A deep <b>repository</b> for nuclear waste.</i>

**safekeeping** The responsibility of a guardian or keeper.  
*She d put her wedding ring in her purse for **safekeeping**.*

**sculpture** Form or shape as if by sculpture especially with strong smooth curves.  
*The boundary between painting and **sculpture** is displaced.*

**statuary** The art or practice of making statues.  
*Classical **statuary**.*

**statue** A sculpture representing a human or animal.

**statuesque** Reminiscent of a statue in size, posture, or stillness.  
*Frozen **statuesque** attitudes.*

**tombstone** A large, flat inscribed stone standing or laid over a grave.  
*His grin exposed his yellowed teeth like a row of **tombstones**.*
