Infinitive	<b>to musicalize</b>
Present Tense	<b>musicalize / musicalizes</b>
Past Tense	<b>musicalized</b>
Present Participle	<b>musicalizing</b>
Past Participle	<b>musicalized</b>

## Conjugate Musicalize

**Musicalize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>musicalize</b>	We <b>musicalize</b>
You <b>musicalize</b>	You <b>musicalize</b>
He/She/It <b>musicalizes</b>	They <b>musicalize</b>

**Musicalize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am musicalizing</b>	We <b>are musicalizing</b>
You <b>are musicalizing</b>	You <b>are musicalizing</b>
He/She/It <b>is musicalizing</b>	They <b>are musicalizing</b>

**Musicalize in Present Perfect Tense**

**Plural**

I <b>have musicalized</b>	We <b>have musicalized</b>
You <b>have musicalized</b>	You <b>have musicalized</b>
He/She/It <b>has musicalized</b>	They <b>have musicalized</b>

**Musicalize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been musicalizing</b>	We <b>have been musicalizing</b>
You <b>have been musicalizing</b>	You <b>have been musicalizing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been musicalizing</b>	They <b>have been musicalizing</b>

<b>I was musicalizing</b>	<b>We were musicalizing</b>
<b>You were musicalizing</b>	<b>You were musicalizing</b>
<b>He/She/It was musicalizing</b>	<b>They were musicalizing</b>

**Musicalize in Past Perfect Tense**

<b>I had musicalized</b>	<b>We had musicalized</b>
<b>You had musicalized</b>	<b>You had musicalized</b>
<b>He/She/It had musicalized</b>	<b>They had musicalized</b>

**Musicalize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>I had been musicalizing</b>	<b>We had been musicalizing</b>
<b>You had been musicalizing</b>	<b>You had been musicalizing</b>
<b>He/She/It had been musicalizing</b>	<b>They had been musicalizing</b>

<b>I will musicalize</b>	<b>We will musicalize</b>
<b>You will musicalize</b>	<b>You will musicalize</b>
<b>He/She/It will musicalize</b>	<b>They will musicalize</b>

<b>I will be musicalizing</b>	<b>We will be musicalizing</b>
