An entertainer who performs a dramatic or musical work for an audience.

A circus performer.

A device for playing recorded music or video. She knows Harry is something of a **player**.



virtuoso

soloist A musician or singer who performs a solo.

He appears as a concerto **soloist** with all the great British orchestras.

A musician who is a consummate master of technique and artistry.

Virtuoso guitar playing.

instrument Equip with instruments for measuring recording or controlling.

instrumentalist An adherent of instrumentalism.

lyricist A person who writes the words for songs.

minstrel Celebrate by singing in the style of minstrels.

They listened to the **minstrel**s singing songs of knightly prowess.

Music the sounds produced by singers or musical instruments or

music reproductions of such sounds.

Couples were dancing to the **music**.

musicologist

An expert in or student of music as an academic subject, as opposed to

someone trained in performance or composition.

novelist A writer of novels.

percussionThe act of playing a percussion instrument.

Percussion instruments.

performanceThe action or process of performing a task or function.

performerAn entertainer who performs a dramatic or musical work for an audience.

A circus **performer**.

pianist A person who plays the piano, especially professionally.

pianoUsed chiefly as a direction or description in music.

The **piano** passages in the composition.

A person who sings.

A pop **singer**.

A bid by which a player undertakes to win five tricks in solo whist.

A musical composition suggestive of a song.
