## Associations of "Muttered" (30 Words)

<b>babble</b>	Flow in an irregular current with a bubbling noise. <i>The <b>babble</b> of a brook.</i>
<b>babbling</b>	The continuous murmuring sound of flowing water. <i>You sound like a <b>babbling</b> fool.</i>
<b>chatter</b>	Cut unevenly with a chattering tool. <i>He was full of inconsequential but amusing <b>chatter</b>.</i>
<b>complain</b>	Express complaints discontent displeasure or unhappiness. <i>Local authorities <b>complained</b> that they lacked sufficient resources.</i>
<a href="#">equivocate</a>	Use ambiguous language so as to conceal the truth or avoid committing oneself. <i>The government have <b>equivocated</b> too often in the past.</i>
<b>equivocation</b>	A statement that is not literally false but that cleverly avoids an unpleasant truth. <i>I say this without <b>equivocation</b>.</i>
<a href="#">evasive</a>	Directed towards avoidance or escape. <i>His answers were brief constrained and <b>evasive</b>.</i>
<b>gibber</b>	Speak rapidly and unintelligibly, typically through fear or shock. <i>They shrieked and <b>gibbered</b> as flames surrounded them.</i>
<b>gibberish</b>	Unintelligible or meaningless speech or writing; nonsense. <i>He talks <b>gibberish</b>.</i>
<b>gripe</b>	Secure a boat with gripes. <i>He seized me by the arms with a rude <b>gripe</b>.</i>
<b>grouch</b>	A trivial complaint. <i>Rock s foremost poet and ill mannered <b>grouch</b>.</i>
<a href="#">grumble</a>	Make complaining remarks or noises under one’s breath. <i>The main <b>grumble</b> is that he spends too much time away.</i>

<b><u>impediment</u></b>	A defect in a person's speech, such as a lisp or stammer. <i>A serious <b>impediment</b> to scientific progress.</i>
<b><u>incoherent</u></b>	Of waves having no stable definite or stable phase relation. <i>He was <b>incoherent</b> with sentiment.</i>
<b>maunder</b>	Talk in a rambling manner. <i>He <b>maunders</b> through the bank composing his thoughts.</i>
<b><u>mumble</u></b>	Say something indistinctly and quietly, making it difficult for others to hear. <i>The old man had no teeth left and <b>mumbled</b> his food.</i>
<b><u>murmur</u></b>	A low continuous indistinct sound; often accompanied by movement of the lips without the production of articulate speech. <i>He had heard hints only <b>murmurs</b>.</i>
<b>muttering</b>	A privately expressed complaint or expression of dissatisfaction. <i>There were disloyal <b>mutterings</b> about his leadership.</i>
<b><u>nonsense</u></b>	Foolish or unacceptable behaviour. <i>He was talking absolute <b>nonsense</b>.</i>
<b>palaver</b>	Lengthy and unproductive discussion. <i>There s a lot of <b>palaver</b> involved.</i>
<b>palter</b>	Equivocate or prevaricate in action or speech. <i>This great work should not be <b>paltered</b> with.</i>
<b>prattle</b>	Foolish or inconsequential talk. <i>She began to <b>prattle</b> on about her visit to the dentist.</i>
<b>prevaricate</b>	Be deliberately ambiguous or unclear in order to mislead or withhold information. <i>He seemed to <b>prevaricate</b> when journalists asked pointed questions.</i>
<b><u>rumble</u></b>	Discover (an illicit activity or its perpetrator). <i>It wouldn t need a genius to <b>rumble</b> my little game.</i>
<b><u>slur</u></b>	Speak disparagingly of e g make a racial slur. <i>It is difficult for a woman to understand a man s sensitivity to any <b>slur</b> on his virility.</i>
<b>speak</b>	Utter (a word, message, etc). <i>I wish to <b>speak</b> privately with you.</i>
<b>stammer</b>	A tendency to stammer. <i>I I can t Isabel <b>stammered</b>.</i>
<b><u>stutter</u></b>	A tendency to stutter while speaking. <i>He shyly <b>stuttered</b> out an invitation to the cinema.</i>
<b>talk</b>	Discussion talk about is a less formal alternative for discussion of. <i>He can <b>talk</b> as well as you or I can.</i>
