**coddle**Treat with excessive indulgence.

Let s not molly coddle our students.

**cosset**Care for and protect in an overindulgent way.

All her life she d been **cosset**ed by her family.

mollycoddle

Treat (someone) in an indulgent or overprotective way.

Let s not mollycoddle our students.

nursemaid Look after or be overprotective towards.

I haven t got time to **nursemaid** you through these problems.

**wait on hand and foot** Serve as a waiter or waitress in a restaurant.
