## Associations of "Narrow down" (30 Words)

adulterate	Corrupt, debase, or make impure by adding a foreign or inferior substance; often by replacing valuable ingredients with inferior ones. <i>Adulterate remedies</i> .
<u>aisle</u>	Part of a church divided laterally from the nave proper by rows of pillars or columns. I spend much of my time at the shops wandering through the <b>aisle</b> s.
antechamber	A large entrance or reception room or area. The <b>antechamber</b> to an interview room.
anteroom	A large room in an officers' mess, typically adjacent to the dining room.
confined	Not invading healthy tissue. Her fear of <b>confined</b> spaces.
corridor	A passage along the side of some railway carriages, from which doors lead into compartments. <i>His room lay at the very end of the corridor</i> .
<u>cramped</u>	Suffering from cramp. There is no way a computer will be able to decipher my <b>cramped</b> handwriting.
descend	Make an unexpected visit to. Three hotels were granted the prestigious five star status whilst others <b>descend</b> ed in quality or maintained their ranking.
descending	Coming down or downward. A passage of <b>descending</b> chords.
downgrade	A downward gradient on a railway or road. A steep <b>downgrade</b> for which he had to put the car in second.
<u>falling</u>	Coming down freely under the influence of gravity. <i>Falling</i> temperatures.
foyer	An entrance hall in a house or flat. The <b>foyer</b> of the concert hall.



gangway	A passage between rows of seats, especially in a theatre or aircraft.
gully	A fielder at gully. <i>He was caught in the <b>gully</b> by Jones.</i>
<u>hall</u>	A large building for meetings or entertainment. <i>Lecture <b>hall</b>.</i>
incised	Cut into with a sharp instrument. An <b>incised</b> design.
isthmus	A narrow strip of land with sea on either side, forming a link between two larger areas of land.
lessen	Wear off or die down. The warmth of the afternoon <b>lessen</b> ed.
<u>lobby</u>	An interest group that tries to influence legislators or bureaucrats to act in their favor typically through lobbying. They insist on their right to <b>lobby</b> Congress.
low	Very low in volume. A <b>low</b> ly parish priest.
nave	The central area of a church.
<u>passage</u>	A narrow way allowing access between buildings or to different rooms within a building a passageway. <i>The larger bedroom was at the end of the <b>passage</b>.</i>
reduce	Reduce in scope while retaining essential elements. The number of priority homeless cases has <b>reduce</b> d slightly.
shrinkage	Process or result of becoming less or smaller. <b>Shrinkage</b> is the retail trade s euphemism for shoplifting.
sink	Cause a ship to sink. This pledge could <b>sink</b> the government.
strait	(of a place) of limited spatial capacity; narrow or cramped. <i>Redundancy left him in severe financial <b>strait</b>s.</i>
submergence	Sinking until covered completely with water. Total <b>submergence</b> of plants results in heavy crop losses.
subnormal	(of a person) having learning difficulties or a developmental disorder. When you lose enough body heat to make your temperature <b>subnormal</b> you become hypothermic.
tidal	Relating to or affected by tides. <i>The river here is not <b>tidal</b>.</i>
<u>under</u>	Under water. He was floating for some time but suddenly went <b>under</b> .
