## Associations of "Narrow down" (30 Words)

<b>adulterate</b>	Corrupt, debase, or make impure by adding a foreign or inferior substance; often by replacing valuable ingredients with inferior ones. <i><b>Adulterate</b> remedies.</i>
<a href="#">aisle</a>	Part of a church divided laterally from the nave proper by rows of pillars or columns. <i>I spend much of my time at the shops wandering through the <b>aisles</b>.</i>
<b>antechamber</b>	A large entrance or reception room or area. <i>The <b>antechamber</b> to an interview room.</i>
<b>anteroom</b>	A large room in an officers' mess, typically adjacent to the dining room.
<b>confined</b>	Not invading healthy tissue. <i>Her fear of <b>confined</b> spaces.</i>
<b>corridor</b>	A passage along the side of some railway carriages, from which doors lead into compartments. <i>His room lay at the very end of the <b>corridor</b>.</i>
<a href="#">cramped</a>	Suffering from cramp. <i>There is no way a computer will be able to decipher my <b>cramped</b> handwriting.</i>
<b>descend</b>	Make an unexpected visit to. <i>Three hotels were granted the prestigious five star status whilst others <b>descended</b> in quality or maintained their ranking.</i>
<b>descending</b>	Coming down or downward. <i>A passage of <b>descending</b> chords.</i>
<b>downgrade</b>	A downward gradient on a railway or road. <i>A steep <b>downgrade</b> for which he had to put the car in second.</i>
<a href="#">falling</a>	Coming down freely under the influence of gravity. <i><b>Falling</b> temperatures.</i>
<b>foyer</b>	An entrance hall in a house or flat. <i>The <b>foyer</b> of the concert hall.</i>

<b>gangway</b>	A passage between rows of seats, especially in a theatre or aircraft.
<b>gully</b>	A fielder at gully. <i>He was caught in the <b>gully</b> by Jones.</i>
<b>hall</b>	A large building for meetings or entertainment. <i>Lecture <b>hall</b>.</i>
<b>incised</b>	Cut into with a sharp instrument. <i>An <b>incised</b> design.</i>
<b>isthmus</b>	A narrow strip of land with sea on either side, forming a link between two larger areas of land.
<b>lessen</b>	Wear off or die down. <i>The warmth of the afternoon <b>lessened</b>.</i>
<b>lobby</b>	An interest group that tries to influence legislators or bureaucrats to act in their favor typically through lobbying. <i>They insist on their right to <b>lobby</b> Congress.</i>
<b>low</b>	Very low in volume. <i>A <b>lowly</b> parish priest.</i>
<b>nave</b>	The central area of a church.
<b>passage</b>	A narrow way allowing access between buildings or to different rooms within a building a passageway. <i>The larger bedroom was at the end of the <b>passage</b>.</i>
<b>reduce</b>	Reduce in scope while retaining essential elements. <i>The number of priority homeless cases has <b>reduced</b> slightly.</i>
<b>shrinkage</b>	Process or result of becoming less or smaller. <i><b>Shrinkage</b> is the retail trade s euphemism for shoplifting.</i>
<b>sink</b>	Cause a ship to sink. <i>This pledge could <b>sink</b> the government.</i>
<b>strait</b>	(of a place) of limited spatial capacity; narrow or cramped. <i>Redundancy left him in severe financial <b>straits</b>.</i>
<b>submergence</b>	Sinking until covered completely with water. <i>Total <b>submergence</b> of plants results in heavy crop losses.</i>
<b>subnormal</b>	(of a person) having learning difficulties or a developmental disorder. <i>When you lose enough body heat to make your temperature <b>subnormal</b> you become hypothermic.</i>
<b>tidal</b>	Relating to or affected by tides. <i>The river here is not <b>tidal</b>.</i>
<b>under</b>	Under water. <i>He was floating for some time but suddenly went <b>under</b>.</i>
