Associations of "Narrow down" (30 Words)

adulterate	Corrupt, debase, or make impure by adding a foreign or inferior substance; often by replacing valuable ingredients with inferior ones. <i>Adulterate remedies.</i>
<u>aisle</u>	Part of a church divided laterally from the nave proper by rows of pillars or columns. <i>I spend much of my time at the shops wandering through the aisles.</i>
antechamber	A large entrance or reception room or area. <i>The antechamber to an interview room.</i>
anteroom	A large room in an officers' mess, typically adjacent to the dining room.
confined	Not invading healthy tissue. <i>Her fear of confined spaces.</i>
corridor	A passage along the side of some railway carriages, from which doors lead into compartments. <i>His room lay at the very end of the corridor.</i>
<u>cramped</u>	Suffering from cramp. <i>There is no way a computer will be able to decipher my cramped handwriting.</i>
descend	Make an unexpected visit to. <i>Three hotels were granted the prestigious five star status whilst others descended in quality or maintained their ranking.</i>
descending	Coming down or downward. <i>A passage of descending chords.</i>
downgrade	A downward gradient on a railway or road. <i>A steep downgrade for which he had to put the car in second.</i>
<u>falling</u>	Coming down freely under the influence of gravity. <i>Falling temperatures.</i>
foyer	An entrance hall in a house or flat. <i>The foyer of the concert hall.</i>

gangway	A passage between rows of seats, especially in a theatre or aircraft.
gully	A fielder at gully. <i>He was caught in the gully by Jones.</i>
hall	A large building for meetings or entertainment. <i>Lecture hall.</i>
incised	Cut into with a sharp instrument. <i>An incised design.</i>
isthmus	A narrow strip of land with sea on either side, forming a link between two larger areas of land.
lessen	Wear off or die down. <i>The warmth of the afternoon lessened.</i>
lobby	An interest group that tries to influence legislators or bureaucrats to act in their favor typically through lobbying. <i>They insist on their right to lobby Congress.</i>
low	Very low in volume. <i>A lowly parish priest.</i>
nave	The central area of a church.
passage	A narrow way allowing access between buildings or to different rooms within a building a passageway. <i>The larger bedroom was at the end of the passage.</i>
reduce	Reduce in scope while retaining essential elements. <i>The number of priority homeless cases has reduced slightly.</i>
shrinkage	Process or result of becoming less or smaller. <i>Shrinkage is the retail trade s euphemism for shoplifting.</i>
sink	Cause a ship to sink. <i>This pledge could sink the government.</i>
strait	(of a place) of limited spatial capacity; narrow or cramped. <i>Redundancy left him in severe financial straits.</i>
submergence	Sinking until covered completely with water. <i>Total submergence of plants results in heavy crop losses.</i>
subnormal	(of a person) having learning difficulties or a developmental disorder. <i>When you lose enough body heat to make your temperature subnormal you become hypothermic.</i>
tidal	Relating to or affected by tides. <i>The river here is not tidal.</i>
under	Under water. <i>He was floating for some time but suddenly went under.</i>
