| deafness        | The condition of lacking the power of hearing or having impaired hearing.<br>The baby is at risk of being born with profound <b>deafness</b> .  |
| fortitude       | Strength of mind that enables one to endure adversity with courage. <i>She endured her illness with great fortitude</i> .                       |
| insensitivity   | The inability to respond to affective changes in your interpersonal environment.<br>Signs of malnutrition include <b>insensitivity</b> to pain. |



| manliness       | The fact of being typically male; masculinity.<br>The author s alleged lack of <b>manliness</b> .  |

| mettle          | A person's ability to cope well with difficulties; spirit and resilience.<br>The team showed their true <b>mettle</b> in the second half.  |
| neural          | Of or relating to the nervous system.<br><i>Neural disorder.</i>   |
| neuron          | A cell that is specialized to conduct nerve impulses.  |
| neuroscientist  | An expert in neuroscience.<br>There is a significant and growing need among <b>neuroscientist</b> s to<br>exchange experimental data.  |
| neurotically    | In a neurotic manner.  |
| olfactory       | Relating to the sense of smell.<br>The <b>olfactory</b> organs.  |
| palsy           | Affect with palsy.<br><i>Is the calmness of philosophy or the <b>palsy</b> of insensibility to be looked for.</i>  |
| paralysis       | Loss of the ability to move a body part.<br>The <b>paralysis</b> gripping the country.   |
| <u>pathway</u>  | A sequence of chemical reactions undergone by a compound or class of compounds in a living organism.<br>These neural <b>pathway</b> s control vocalization.  |
| <u>prowess</u>  | A superior skill that you can learn by study and practice and observation. <i>His <b>prowess</b> as a fisherman.</i>   |
| resourcefulness | The ability to find quick and clever ways to overcome difficulties.<br>A man of great <b>resourcefulness</b> .   |
| <u>sensory</u>  | Of a nerve fiber or impulse originating outside and passing toward the central nervous system. <i>Sensory experience</i> .   |
| synapse         | A junction between two nerve cells, consisting of a minute gap across<br>which impulses pass by diffusion of a neurotransmitter.<br><i>Nerve impulses cross a synapse</i> through the action of neurotransmitters. |
| unflinching     | Not showing fear or hesitation in the face of danger or difficulty.<br><i>He has shown <b>unflinching</b> determination throughout the campaign.</i>   |
| <u>valor</u>    | The qualities of a hero or heroine; exceptional or heroic courage when facing danger (especially in battle. <i>He received a medal for valor</i> .   |
