## Associations of "Nestled" (30 Words)

- astride** With a leg on each side of something.  
*He stood legs **astride**.*
- auditorium** A large building or hall used for public gatherings, typically speeches or stage performances.  
*The National Indoor Arena is a magnificent **auditorium** and one of Britain's premier indoor venues.*
- below** Below deck.  
*See **below**.*
- bench** Exhibit on a bench.  
*A park **bench**.*
- chair** The person in charge of a meeting or of an organization used as a neutral alternative to chairman or chairwoman.  
*He is second **chair** violin.*

<b>crouch</b>	A crouching stance or posture. <i>Leo was <b>crouched</b> before the fire.</i>
<b>cushion</b>	The elastic lining of the sides of a billiard table, from which the ball rebounds. <i>Comfortable chairs and sofas piled with <b>cushions</b>.</i>
<b>descend</b>	Do something that one considers to be below one's dignity. <i>An air of gloom <b>descended</b> on Labour Party headquarters.</i>
<b>desk</b>	A counter in a hotel, bank, or airport at which a customer may check in or obtain information. <i>A <b>desk</b> job.</i>
<b>dining</b>	The act of eating dinner. <i>A <b>dining</b> area.</i>
<b>down</b>	Denoting a flavour variety of stable quark having relatively low mass and an electric charge of $-\frac{1}{3}$ In the Standard Model protons and neutrons are composed of up and down quarks. <i>He <b>downed</b> a 20 foot putt for victory.</i>
<b>flop</b>	With a flopping sound. <i>This computer can perform a million <b>flops</b> per second.</i>
<b>idly</b>	In an idle manner. <i>I can no longer stand <b>idly</b> by and let him take the blame.</i>
<b>incubate</b>	Grow under conditions that promote development. <i>The samples were <b>incubated</b> at 80 C for 3 minutes.</i>
<b>kneel</b>	Be in or assume a position in which the body is supported by a knee or the knees, as when praying or showing submission. <i>In church you have to <b>kneel</b> during parts of the service.</i>
<b>locate</b>	Discover the exact place or position of. <i>Our sense of sight enables us to <b>locate</b> objects in space.</i>
<b>located</b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Valuable centrally <b>located</b> urban land.</i>
<b>park</b>	Bring a vehicle that one is driving to a halt and leave it temporarily typically in a car park or by the side of the road. <i><b>Park</b> the car in the yard.</i>
<b>proscenium</b>	The part of a modern theater stage between the curtain and the orchestra (i.e., in front of the curtain).
<b>recliner</b>	An armchair whose back can be lowered and foot can be raised to allow the sitter to recline in it.
<b>seat</b>	Be able to seat. <i>He was elected to a <b>seat</b> in the Senate.</i>

<b>settle</b>	Settle into a position usually on a surface or ground. <i>Try to <b>settle</b> your puppy down before going to bed.</i>
<b>sit</b>	A period of sitting. <i>You can <b>sit</b> wherever you like.</i>
<b>snuggle</b>	Position comfortably. <i>She <b>snuggled</b> her head into his shoulder.</i>
<b>squat</b>	A squatting position. <i>He can <b>squat</b> 850 pounds.</i>
<b>table</b>	The dummy hand which is exposed on the table. <i>It was a sturdy <b>table</b>.</i>
<b>tensile</b>	Relating to tension. <i>Made of highly <b>tensile</b> steel alloy.</i>
<b>terrace</b>	Provide a house with a terrace. <i>Modern furniture looks out of place in your Victorian <b>terrace</b>.</i>
<b>warm</b>	In a warm manner. <i>Made things <b>warm</b> for the bookies.</i>
<b>workbench</b>	A strong worktable for a carpenter or mechanic.
