Present Tense	<b>net / nets</b>
Past Tense	<b>netted</b>
Present Participle	<b>netting</b>
Past Participle	<b>netted</b>

## Conjugate Net

**Net in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>net</b>	We <b>net</b>
You <b>net</b>	You <b>net</b>
He/She/It <b>nets</b>	They <b>net</b>

## **Net in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am netting</b>	We <b>are netting</b>
You <b>are netting</b>	You <b>are netting</b>
He/She/It <b>is netting</b>	They <b>are netting</b>

## **Net in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have netted</b>	We <b>have netted</b>
You <b>have netted</b>	You <b>have netted</b>
He/She/It <b>has netted</b>	They <b>have netted</b>

## **Net in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been netting</b>	We <b>have been netting</b>
You <b>have been netting</b>	You <b>have been netting</b>
He/She/It <b>has been netting</b>	They <b>have been netting</b>

## **Net in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>netted</b>	We <b>netted</b>
You <b>netted</b>	You <b>netted</b>
He/She/It <b>netted</b>	They <b>netted</b>

## **Net in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was netting</b>	We <b>were netting</b>
You <b>were netting</b>	You <b>were netting</b>
He/She/It <b>was netting</b>	They <b>were netting</b>

**Net in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had netted</b>	We <b>had netted</b>
You <b>had netted</b>	You <b>had netted</b>
He/She/It <b>had netted</b>	They <b>had netted</b>

**Net in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been netting</b>	We <b>had been netting</b>
You <b>had been netting</b>	You <b>had been netting</b>
He/She/It <b>had been netting</b>	They <b>had been netting</b>

**Net in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I <b>will net</b>	We <b>will net</b>
You <b>will net</b>	You <b>will net</b>
He/She/It <b>will net</b>	They <b>will net</b>

**Net in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I <b>will be netting</b>	We <b>will be netting</b>
You <b>will be netting</b>	You <b>will be netting</b>
He/She/It <b>will be netting</b>	They <b>will be netting</b>

**Net in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have netted**

**We will have netted**

**You will have netted**

**You will have netted**

**He/She/It will have netted**

**They will have netted**

**Net in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been netting**

**We will have been netting**

**You will have been netting**

**You will have been netting**

**He/She/It will have been netting**

**They will have been netting**
