Definitions of "Never" as an adverb

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "never" as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- Not ever; at no time in the past or future.
- (expressing surprise) surely not.
- Not at all; certainly not; not in any circumstances.
- At no time in the past or future; not ever.
- Not at all.

certainly not Definitely or positively (`sure' is sometimes used

informally for `surely.

in no circumstances To or toward the inside of.

ne'er Not ever; at no time in the past or future.

not ever At all times; all the time and on every occasion.

not in any circumstances To or toward the inside of.

not once At a previous time.

not under any circumstances Further down.

on no account Referring to the degree to which a certain quality is


present.

on no occasion Referring to the degree to which a certain quality is

present.

under no circumstances Further down.

- *I* will never ever forget it.
- He never turned up.
- I shall never forget this day.
- They had never been camping in their lives.
- Had never seen a circus.
- Never on Sunday.
- I have never been to China.
- What, you, Annabel? Never!
