<b>beginning</b>	The event consisting of the start of something. <i>He left at the <b>beginning</b> of February.</i>
<b>bracing</b>	A structural member used to stiffen a framework. <i>The <b>bracing</b> sea air.</i>
<b>creation</b>	Everything that exists anywhere. <i>From its <b>creation</b> the plan was doomed to failure.</i>
<b>creatively</b>	In an original or imaginative way. <i>This article inspires you to think <b>creatively</b>.</i>
<b>creativeness</b>	The ability to create.
<b>emergent</b>	An emergent property. <i><b>Emergent</b> repair of an aorta.</i>
<b>emerging</b>	Becoming apparent or prominent. <i>Established and <b>emerging</b> artists.</i>
<b>fresh</b>	(of a person) full of energy and vigour. <i>A <b>fresh</b> start.</i>
<b>freshly</b>	In an impudent or impertinent manner. <i><b>Freshly</b> ground black pepper.</i>
<b>freshness</b>	Brightness or healthiness of complexion or appearance. <i>The restaurant's selling point is the <b>freshness</b> of its ingredients.</i>
<a href="#"><b>groundbreaking</b></a>	Being or producing something like nothing done or experienced or created before. <i><b>Groundbreaking</b> research into fertility problems.</i>
<a href="#"><b>imaginative</b></a>	Having or showing creativity or inventiveness. <i>An <b>imaginative</b> use of material.</i>

<b>inaugurate</b>	Admit (someone) formally to office. <i>The new President will be <b>inaugurated</b> on January 20.</i>
<b>inchoate</b>	Only partly in existence; imperfectly formed. <i><b>Inchoate</b> proletarian protest.</i>
<b>initially</b>	At the beginning. <i><b>Initially</b> he thought the new concept was nonsense.</i>
<b>innovative</b>	Ahead of the times. <i>Is British industry <b>innovative</b> enough.</i>
<b>introduce</b>	Introduce. <i>A new word processor was <b>introduced</b>.</i>
<b><u>inventive</u></b>	(used of persons or artifacts) marked by independence and creativity in thought or action. <i>A courageous and <b>inventive</b> piece of film making.</i>
<b><u>nascent</u></b>	(especially of a process or organization) just coming into existence and beginning to display signs of future potential. <i>A <b>nascent</b> insurgency.</i>
<b>newly</b>	Very recently. <i>Social confidence for the <b>newly</b> single.</i>
<b><u>novelty</u></b>	Cheap showy jewelry or ornament on clothing. <i>The <b>novelty</b> of being a married woman wore off.</i>
<b>recency</b>	A time immediately before the present.
<b>recent</b>	Approximately the last 10,000 years. <i>A <b>recent</b> edition of the newspaper.</i>
<b>recently</b>	In the recent past. <i>Until <b>recently</b> we had a female doctor.</i>
<b><u>refreshing</u></b>	Serving to refresh or reinvigorate someone. <i>It makes a <b>refreshing</b> change to be able to write about something nice.</i>
<b>straightforwardness</b>	Without hypocrisy. <i>What some people take for rudeness is really <b>straightforwardness</b>.</i>
<b>unconventional</b>	Not conforming to legality, moral law, or social convention. <i>Her <b>unconventional</b> dress and hair style.</i>
<b>unveil</b>	Remove the cover from. <i>Women must not <b>unveil</b> themselves in public in some religious societies.</i>
