begin	Have a beginning characterized in some specified way. <i>A terrible murder begins the novel.</i>
beginning	The event consisting of the start of something. <i>He left at the beginning of February.</i>
bracing	A structural member used to stiffen a framework. <i>The bracing sea air.</i>
creation	Everything that exists anywhere. <i>From its creation the plan was doomed to failure.</i>
creatively	In an original or imaginative way. <i>This article inspires you to think creatively.</i>
creativeness	The ability to create.
emergent	An emergent property. <i>Emergent repair of an aorta.</i>
emerging	Becoming apparent or prominent. <i>Established and emerging artists.</i>
fresh	(of a person) full of energy and vigour. <i>A fresh start.</i>
freshly	In an impudent or impertinent manner. <i>Freshly ground black pepper.</i>
freshness	Brightness or healthiness of complexion or appearance. <i>The restaurant's selling point is the freshness of its ingredients.</i>
groundbreaking	Being or producing something like nothing done or experienced or created before. <i>Groundbreaking research into fertility problems.</i>
imaginative	Having or showing creativity or inventiveness. <i>An imaginative use of material.</i>

inaugurate	Admit (someone) formally to office. <i>The new President will be inaugurated on January 20.</i>
inchoate	Only partly in existence; imperfectly formed. <i>Inchoate proletarian protest.</i>
initially	At the beginning. <i>Initially he thought the new concept was nonsense.</i>
innovative	Ahead of the times. <i>Is British industry innovative enough.</i>
introduce	Introduce. <i>A new word processor was introduced.</i>
<u>inventive</u>	(used of persons or artifacts) marked by independence and creativity in thought or action. <i>A courageous and inventive piece of film making.</i>
<u>nascent</u>	(especially of a process or organization) just coming into existence and beginning to display signs of future potential. <i>A nascent insurgency.</i>
newly	Very recently. <i>Social confidence for the newly single.</i>
<u>novelty</u>	Cheap showy jewelry or ornament on clothing. <i>The novelty of being a married woman wore off.</i>
recency	A time immediately before the present.
recent	Approximately the last 10,000 years. <i>A recent edition of the newspaper.</i>
recently	In the recent past. <i>Until recently we had a female doctor.</i>
<u>refreshing</u>	Serving to refresh or reinvigorate someone. <i>It makes a refreshing change to be able to write about something nice.</i>
straightforwardness	Without hypocrisy. <i>What some people take for rudeness is really straightforwardness.</i>
unconventional	Not conforming to legality, moral law, or social convention. <i>Her unconventional dress and hair style.</i>
unveil	Remove the cover from. <i>Women must not unveil themselves in public in some religious societies.</i>
