recently	At a recent time; not long ago. <i>Until recently we had a female doctor.</i>
refreshing	Welcome or stimulating because new or different. <i>It makes a refreshing change to be able to write about something nice.</i>
shortly	For a short time. <i>The new database will shortly be available for consultation.</i>
stylish	Fashionably elegant and sophisticated. <i>A stylish cocktail bar.</i>
transfigure	Change completely the nature or appearance of. <i>The world is made luminous and is transfigured.</i>
ultramodern	Extremely modern. <i>Dadism and ultramodern art.</i>
unconventional	Not conventional or conformist. <i>Unconventional life styles.</i>
